WHEREAS, a declaration of civil preparedness emergency was issued by the Governor on October 27, 2012 in anticipation of the severe weather caused by Hurricane Sandy;

WHEREAS, a declaration of civil preparedness emergency was issued by the Governor on February 8, 2013 due to the severe snow storm that impacted the state;

WHEREAS, Connecticut General Statutes section 28-9(b) authorizes and empowers the Governor to take such steps as are reasonably necessary in light of such emergency to protect the health, safety and welfare of the people of the state, and to modify and suspend in whole or in part, any statute, regulation or requirement or part thereof, whenever the Governor is of the opinion that it is in conflict with the efficient and expeditious execution of civil preparedness functions;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the this authority, the Governor issued Executive Orders 21 – 28 (Hurricane Sandy) and Executive Order 30 (February Snow Storm); and

WHEREAS, there is no longer a need to continue the states of civil preparedness emergency or keep in force the executive orders issued in connection therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Dannel P. Malloy, Governor of the State of Connecticut, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the states of civil preparedness emergency declared by the Governor on October 27, 2012 and February 8, 2013 are hereby ended;
- 2. That Executive Orders 21-28 and 30 are hereby rescinded; and
- 3. That nothing in this order shall be construed to invalidate any actions taken pursuant to or in reasonable reliance on such orders, whether such activities have concluded or are ongoing.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
