2. Plate requests must be made for a vehicle currently registered in Connecticut. (Applications for vehicles currently registered with Temporary plates will not be accepted).
3. You may only acquire the same registration type as you currently have on your vehicle. (Example: If your vehicle is currently registered with Passenger plate types, you can only request a Passenger plate NOT a Commercial or Combination plate.

B. Place a check mark in the area indicating NEW VANITY PLATE.

2. For All Other Plate Orders: A. Complete Sections 1,2 , and 3
B. Place a check mark in the area indicating the plate you wish to obtain.
