These parties are interested in growing nut trees. The two remaining trees of Russell's are 4 ft. high and one has bloomed.

About 6 yrs. ago he bought 5 Chinese chestnut seedlings (3ft.) from Bixby; these are about 10 ft. high now. This is the 4th yr. they have borne and last yr. had several qts. of fine nuts. Has quite a few seedlings from planted nuts.

Also has 4 Riehl hybrids next to the above trees that are bearing this year.
