10/21/30 Mr. Johnson died 1926. Sold prop. to Fred C. Rummel, 729 Concord St., Framingham Mass. House burned at So. Sudbury

10/1/30 Mr. Rummel has sold place. Inquire of Collector of Taxes about property on 11/4/30

1/6/31 - Write Chas Goodnow Jr. (who lives near) for info re trees

1/27/31 - Goodnow advises alive and apparently healthy. 10% show signs of blight. Planted among native chestnut & other small oaks etc.

1/30/31 Sent C.R. Bul. to Goodnow.
