He has 14 grafted varieties of Chinese and Japanese chestnuts,  
plus numerous hybrids and seedlings. -- GFG

P. 87: "Of the older Chinese chestnut varieties in my hands,  
Hobson has excelled, with large chestnuts (3 1/4 to the pound in  
1948). Zimmerman also produces a good nut. Colossal (hybrid)  
is very productive and produces the largest nuts of any chest-  
nut that I have seen growing in Tennessee, but the quality of  
the raw nut is not equal to Hobson. It refuses to grow on  
Chinese stock but thrives on Japanese. It is pollen sterile.  
I have several newer varieties under observation, and although  
they are growing vigorously I have not had time to form an  
opinion on them."
