Listed in this report for 1967 are the manufacturer's names, the number of samples of the products of each manufacturer collected, the number of these samples found deficient and the ratios of the percentages of nitrogen, phosphoric acid, and potash found to the percentages guaranteed. Results of 666 samples of fertilizer produced by 126 manufacturers are summarized. A table of the tonnage sold during the period between July 1, 1966 and June 30, 1967 is included.
