

Engine Co. 31 initially checked out with nothing showing from a two-story multi family apartment building. Upon further investigation crews found heavy smoke inside a single unit on division one [582] prompting Battalion 5-0 to strike a working fire assignment. Crews made an aggressive push to the seat of the fire and got a quick knockdown on what was a well involved unit. Thanks to the quick actions by the first due companies, crews were able to keep the fire held to the unit of origin. Battalion Chief 5 was able to out tap the box at the 40 min time stamp. The roof firefighters reported a plywood ceiling. This allowed for additional fire spread as companies had a hard time getting into the void spaces. The fire took about an hour and a half to bring under control. The cause is being investigated by the fire marshal's office. One firefighter was injured fighting the blaze.



Companies dealt with heavy fire on all floors and battled exposure problems; multiple aerial master streams were utilized to knock down heavy fire before transitioning to an interior attack. The fire was under control in about an hour and a half, and a detail crew stayed overnight.


