
STEP-BY-STEP Process



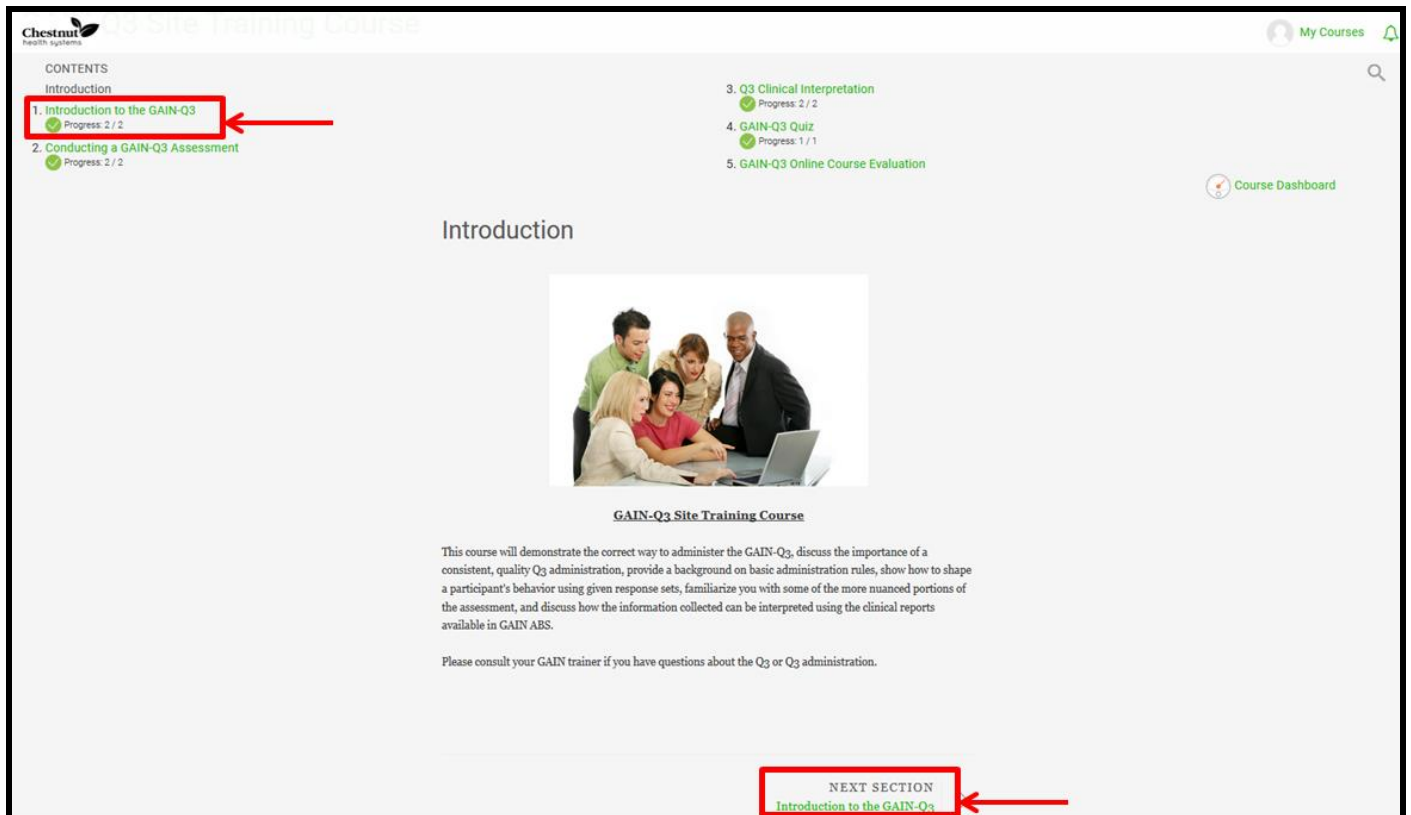
