If you do not notify DCF within three years of the deferral of the case, the allegations shall remain in the Department's record as substantiated. If your name is placed on the Central Registry, DCF will be allowed to disclose the information in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, sections 17a-28 and 17a-101k.
