1. Recommend to the commissioner programs, legislation or other matters which will improve services for children and youths, including behavioral health services
2. Annually review and advise the commissioner regarding the proposed budget
3. Interpret to the community at large the policies, duties and programs of the department
4. Issue any reports it deems necessary to the Governor and the Commissioner of Children and Families
5. Assist in the development of and review and comment on the strategic plan developed by the department pursuant to subsection (b) of section 17a-3
6. Receive on a quarterly basis from the commissioner a status report on the Department's progress in carrying out the strategic plan
7. Independently monitor the department's progress in achieving its goals as expressed in the strategic plan
8. Offer assistance and provide outside perspective to the department so that it may be able to achieve the goals as expressed in the strategic plan.

**The below schedule will promote compliance with the above duties.** Recurrent themes within discussions include: the Strategic Plan, Racial/Social Justice, Child Welfare, Behavioral Health

SAC members are encouraged to inform their RACs and DCF Regional Administrators with the below schedule to promote linkages in the discussions between the RACs and the SAC.

**Responsibilities of SAC members:** to attend SAC and RAC meetings, bring RAC concerns/needs/updates to the SAC, promote collaboration in regards to the Strategic Plan, promote opportunities for youth and family involvement
