DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION IMPLEMENTATION ORDER To Implement Governor Lamont Executive Order 7R

Pursuant to Executive Order 7R, the Department of Consumer Protection (the “Department”) issues the following rules and procedures to implement the orders and directives therein.

Limits on Curbside Delivery by Package Stores and Grocery Stores

Permittees holding a package store permit or a grocery store beer permit may provide curbside delivery of all alcoholic beverages allowed by their permit type in any space adjacent to their permit premises subject to the following limitations:

1. That the receiver of the alcoholic liquor must be of legal drinking age and not intoxicated;
2. That the receiver of the alcoholic liquor must present a valid operator’s license or state identity card if the age of the receiver is in doubt;
3. That if the age of the receiver is in doubt, the sale and delivery must be declined at that time. The use of age statement forms is not authorized; and
4. That the deliverer of the alcoholic liquor to the receiver must be at least eighteen years of age and employed as an employee of the permit premises.
