## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

On February 1, 2018, after due and proper notice, the Department of Consumer Protection, Liquor Control Division, held a formal administrative hearing on the alleged violation of Section 30-54 of the Connecticut General Statutes and Sections 30-6-A24(a) and 30-6-A12 of the Regulations of State Agencies. It was alleged after an inspection that the Permittee was not in compliance with insurance requirements, the permittee name sign was not posted adjacent to the main entrance of the permit premises and the liquor permit was not hung and framed in plain view. Despite proper notice, Amanda L. Beltre, Permittee, did not appear.

Based upon the testimony at the hearing and documents submitted into the record, the Liquor Control Commission hereby dismisses the charges.
