On December 18, 2008, after due notice, the Department of Consumer Protection, Liquor Control Commission, held a formal administrative hearing on a charge of a violation of Section 30-39(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes, and Sec. 30-6-A3 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, arising out of your failure to obtain or provide the required fire marshal approval form for renewal of your café liquor permit. Despite proper notice, the respondent did not appear at the December 18, 2008, formal administrative hearing.

Based upon the testimony and documents submitted at the hearing, the Department of Consumer Protection finds you to be in violation and, in accordance with §30-6-A8(c) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, **ORDERS** your café liquor permit **suspended immediately** until such time as proof of such fire marshal approval form has been submitted to this department and reinstatement of such permit suspension has been issued.
