1. 8:30 AM call to order. (Reminder to everyone to place their cell phones on "silent"). Chairman Vallieres called the meeting to order at 8:35 AM.

2. Review Minutes of Previous Meetings:

7. Review of Applications(s) for Licensure Examination: applicant(s) appearing in person.

Mr. Vallieres advised all in attendance at today's meeting of the Board general rules and guidelines as they apply to applicants appearing before them for consideration to sit for their respective license examinations. - (1) <u>Bolton, Hervin S.</u> E-1 applicant seeking approval on the basis of equivalent experience and training. Although present at today's meeting, Mr. Bolton choose not to present his application to the Board since he did not have all the documentation he needed and will reschedule his appearance.

The Board voted unanimously to table his application pending receipt of a detailed breakdown of his on-the-job training including notarized statements from his past employers as to dates and duties of employment. 19. Review of Correspondence:

- (A) <u>Evaluation Forms For Continuing Education Course</u>; for the Board's review and information. The Board reviewed this information and thanked the Department for the same.
- (B) Statistical Data concerning licensed Connecticut Electricians and the required 4 hour continuing education requisite; for the Board's information. The Board reviewed this information and thanked the Department for the same.
- (C) Proposed Draft concerning Homeowner Exemptions from Licensing Requirements; for discussion by the Board. Mr. Hurlburt believes this draft addresses and clarifies many issues local Building Officials have had such as electrical service entrances on residences were being disturbed by the homeowners. This draft "suggests legislative changes to provide for properly licensed persons to always provide for the main service or disconnection means of household systems for the protection of the public".

"NEW" proposed wording

(11) persons engaged in the installation, maintenance, repair and service of glass or electrical, plumbing, fire protection sprinkler systems, solar, heating, piping, cooling

and sheet metal equipment in and about single-family residences owned and occupied or to be occupied by such persons, where such connection of water, fuel, or electrical source commences at a disconnection means previously installed by persons licensed for such work; provide any such installation, maintenance and repair shall be subject to inspection and approval by the Building Official of the municipality in which such residence is located and shall conform to the requirements of the State Building Code.

After more extensive discussion, the Board voted unanimously to accept Mr. Hurlburt's proposed modifications and recommend that the Department of Consumer Protection submit the same for a legislative change. (Soter/Halloran)

(D) Connecticut Consumer Protection Occupational Trades License Counts based on mailing address, as of June 6, 2012; for the Board's information. The Board reviewed this information and thanked the Department for the same.

- (A) Continuation of discussion concerning Northeast Utilities Meter Socket Transfer Switch Policy; for discussion by the Board. The Board voted unanimously to postpone discussion on this Item until their August 10, 2012 Regular Meeting.

Mr. Hurlburt was informed by the Department of Public Safety that this Supplement will be available in the near future. After more discussion, the Board voted to accept all the proposed amendments made by Mr. Hurlburt. (Halloran/Yusza). Mr. Vallieres will redraft the 2013 Curriculum Outline and send the same to the Department for distribution to all the providers.
