MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The Board voted unanimously to approve minutes of the April 28, 2009 Fire Protection Sprinkler Systems Work Examining Board meeting with amendments to page-6 under "Comments From Public Present Today", to reflect that the Board unanimously concluded that the Wirsbo Aquapex tubing alternate fire sprinkler system described within Mr. Wysocki's handout presented to the Board is in fact fire protection sprinkler work and falls under the fire protection sprinkler work license category.
