DCP COMPLAINT STATUS REPORT

The Board is requesting Richard Maloney, Trade Enforcement Director to appear before them to do a summation of 2011 complaints and provide a complaint report (open, closed or indifferent).

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Mr. Waskowicz said he met the DCP Commissioner, Richard M. Hurlburt and Elisa Nahas to discuss PSI reviewing and screening applications and applications going back and forth to applicants, and that PSI should be only processing monies. Solution presented by Mr. Waskowicz was to have the Board meetings every twenty-eight days, and that clerical support use is the reason why the Board meetings went to every other month, and that the Board had an issue with the PSI date stamps on applications reflecting several date stamps. Mr. Waskowicz reported that the PSI date stamp on the application is when the 30-day clock starts ticking and that there is no penalty if applications are not acted on within thirty days. Mr. Waskowicz questioned the definition of a quorum which should consist of the majority of the Board members and not the forty percent as noted on the newly passed public act. Mr. Waskowicz said he offered video conferencing as an option and it was not accepted. Mr. Waskowicz further reported that DCP Commissioner approved the Board to meet at 10:00 a.m. that Board meetings will be held every two weeks and that the legislation was passed to eliminate undue waiting time for exam approval.
- 2. The Board expressed concerning with the CT Department of Labor Apprenticeship certificate no longer having a signature.
- 3. Mr. Waskowicz provided his second Board gender and racial composition report.
