PERSONS PRESENT SEEKING GUIDANCE FROM THE BOARD:

Bo Adams, Denver, CO - No application pending

Mr. Adams appeared to seek general guidance on which license type(s) that he may qualify for based on his background and experience.

The Board discussed Mr. Adams' options to obtain a license in Connecticut.

Jason A. Feliciano, East Granby, CT – No application pending

Mr. Feliciano appeared for general licensing discussion regarding his potential approvability for the D-1 exam; he has held the S-2 license since 1/4/12.

The Board discussed Mr. Feliciano's options for licensing.

Michael Fiore -- No application pending

Mr. Fiore appeared to seek general guidance of licensing requirements.

The Board discussed general licensing requirements.

Robert J. Johnson, Higganum, CT – No application pending

Mr. Johnson is appearing for a general discussion on licensing. He has held the OE-2 since 11/19/2010 and wishes to upgrade to an S-2.

Mr. Johnson did not appear; no action taken.

Doug Kinz – No application pending

Mr. Kinz is appearing for a general discussion on sheet metal licensing. He holds a Mass. license and is hoping for an assurance that should he apply that his application would be approved by the Board.

The Board advised that Mr. Kinz would be approved for SM-2 exam upon his submittal of application. Upon passage of SM-2, DCP may waive 2-year waiting period for contractor type.

Michael Maulucci, Plainville, CT - No application pending

Mr. Maulucci is appearing in person for a general discussion on licensing. He has held the B-2 license since 11/22/2004 and wishes to upgrade.

Mr. Maulucci did not appear; no action taken.

Sandor Rozsa, Katonah, NY – No application pending Mr. Rozsa appeared for a general discussion regarding upgrading/consolidating licenses.

PERSONS APPEARING REQUESTING REINSTATEMENT:

Jeffrey Piccoli, Harwinton, CT – (SM-2) Sheet metal journeyperson Mr. Piccoli appeared to discuss reinstatement of SM-2 license.

The Board stated that Mr. Piccoli's license has lapsed; he must re-take SM-2 exam as required.

NEW APPLICATIONS RECEIVED:

Joseph A. Dawson, Mamaroneck, NY – (D-2) Limited Journeyperson Mr. Dawson is seeking a D-2 license based on equivalent experience and training.

Board voted to deny application due to lack of on the job training (the only job training was at one facility) and lack of school-related instruction, as shown.

Robert A. Eilert, Middletown, NY – (SM-2) – Limited Sheet Metal Journeyperson Mr. Eilert is seeking an SM-2 license; he presents documentation from local 38.

The Board approved Mr. Eilert's SM-2 application.

Michael G. Lavoie, Jr., Prospect, CT – (S-2) Unlimited Journeyperson

Mr. Lavoie is seeking an S-2 license; he has held a P-1 license since 2005. No other documentation is provided.

The Board denied Mr. Lavoie's application due to lack of on the job training and schoolrelated instruction equivalent to an apprenticeship program.

John M. McDonald, Norwalk, CT – (S-1) Unlimited Contractor

Mr. McDonald is seeking an S-1 license; he has held a P-1 license since 2008. He provides a copy of his current P-1 license and his statement of qualifications.

The Board denied Mr. McDonald's application due to lack of on the job training and schoolrelated instruction equivalent to an apprenticeship program, and he must hold journeyperson license type first and show apprenticeship completion

Brien R. Stanwicks, Newington, CT – (SM-2) – Limited Sheet Metal Journeyperson Mr. Stanwicks is requesting a SM-2 license based on equivalent experience and training.

Mr. Stanwicks was approved last month for SM-2 application.

APPEALS ON APPLICATIONS PREVIOUSLY DENIED :

Thomas A. Alexander, Campbell Hall, NY – (D-2) Limited Journeyperson Mr. Alexander was denied on 6/19/12. He is appearing in person with additional information

The Board approved Mr. Alexander for D-2 exam, pending receipt of universal CFC card.

Cesar Canales, New Rochelle, NY – No application pending Mr. Canales was denied on 5/17/12. He appeared for to seek guidance regarding denial.

The Board approved Mr. Canales for D-2 exam.

Eugene R. Clement, III, East Granby, CT – (S-9) Limited Contractor

Mr. Clement, III's application was denied on 9/6/12; he is appearing in person to appeal that decision and to present more information to the board.

Mr. Clement did not appear; no action taken.

Mark Silva, Yorktown Heights, NY – (D-1) Limited Contractor

Mr. Silva is appearing in person to appeal the Board's 2/13/12 denial of his current D-1 application due to the lack of the pre-requisite D-2 license. In 1999 Mr. Silva was approved for the D-2 exam but failed on the one attempt made. He then applied for the D-1 in 2009. That application was converted to a D-2 and approved, but no exam attempts were made on that application.

The Board denied Mr. Silva's D-1 application, however, the Board approved for D-2, pending receipt of universal CFC card.

APPEALS ON APPLICATIONS PREVIOUSLY DENIED:

Richard Noack, Bellville, TX – (G-1) Limited Journeyperson Mr. Noack is applied for a G-1 license.

The Board denied G-1 application, but approved for G-2 exam

Andrew A. Read, Issaquah, WA – (D-1) Limited Contractor

Mr. Read wishes to appeal the Board's 1/10/13 denial of his application due to lack of documentation of his on-the-job training and classroom trade-related instruction. Additional material has been faxed in his employer PSF Mechanical.

Board denied D-1, but upon proof of CFC, DCP may approve for D-2 exam. Upon passage of D2, DCP may waive 2-year waiting period for contractor type.
