APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The Commission approves the minutes of September 26, 2017.

PROVISIONALS:

1. **PATEL, MITUL – LIH.1894-B** Villa Bianca, Seymour, CT
Upon reconsideration and an initial inspection by the agent, the Commission approves the issuance of the provisional permit when in receipt of return and cancelation of LRC-218, bill of sale, seller's affidavit, and \$400.00 fees. The Commission approves request allowing wholesalers to extend credit while the premises operates with a provisional permit. Endorse three (3) additional consumer bars.
2. **MCKINNEY, SCOTT – LCA.7953** Lebanon Tap Room, Lebanon, CT
The Commission approves the issuance of the provisional liquor permit upon receipt of \$500.00 fee, cancelation of permit # LCA.7731 and seller's affidavit. The Commission approves the request allowing wholesalers to extend credit while the premises operates with a provisional liquor permit.

3. **ODDO, MARGARET – LCA.7972** Maggie’s Pizzeria & Pub, Norwich, CT
The Commission approves the issuance of the provisional liquor permit upon receipt of copy of CT sales and use tax permit. The Commission approves the request allowing wholesalers to extend credit while the premises operates with a provisional liquor permit. Endorse (1) additional consumer bar and patio.

4. **POLOZANI, ASIM – LIR.19766** Prime Pub, Danbury, CT
The Commission approves the issuance of the provisional liquor permit upon receipt of executed copy of lease or right to occupy LL signature, 8x10 photo of the exterior of the premises taken from a position directly across the street or highway showing the trade name sign and 8x10 photos of the completed and furnished entire interior. Additional requirements: complete Section E #27 and Section G #32 of the application. The Commission approves the request allowing wholesalers to extend credit while the premises operates with a provisional liquor permit. Endorse patio.

5. **ANDREWS, CALLIS – LIR.19780** Maxines on Main, Waterbury, CT
The Commission approves the issuance of the provisional liquor permit. The Commission approves the request allowing wholesalers to extend credit while the premises operates with a provisional liquor permit.

6. **PUNAK, REBEKAH – LTR.244** Maplebear Delivery LLC, San Francisco, CA
The Commission approves the issuance of final permit.

7. **HEATH, RICHARD – LRC.298** Seabury, Bloomfield, CT
The Commission approves the issuance of the final permit. The Commission approves the transfer of fees (\$1450.00) from LIR-19673 to LRC-298. Endorse patio and endorse interior access. The Commission reviews case 2017-800 and determines that the premises qualifies as a restaurant caterer permit. Case 2017-800 to be closed as no violation.

8. **LOPEZ, -CABRERA, CARLOS V. – LIR.19720** Saltwater Restaurant & Bar, Norwalk, CT
The Commission approves the issuance of the final permit when in receipt of the publication notice and 8X10 photo of the exterior of the premises showing the trade name sign. The Commission approves request waiving the effective separation requirement for good cause.
