MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The Board voted unanimously to approve minutes of the March 21, 2011 Plumbing and Piping Work Examining Board meeting.

APPLICATIONS

Matthew Bogacz, Chicopee, MA – (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – No Action Mr. Bogacz did not appear today and the Board took no action.

Frank Demeyer, Holtsville, NY – (P-9) Limited Contractor – Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Demeyer's application due to lack of a required (P-8) Limited Journeyperson license for a minimum of two years.

Chris Georgoulis, Norwalk, CT - (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson - Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Georgoulis' application due to lack of a required "Apprenticeship Completion Certificate". The Board requested Mr. Georgoulis' application be referred to DCP Trade Enforcement Division for investigation of employers (Murace Plumbing Co., Inc., B & G Piping and Levco Oil Co.) permitting applicant to perform plumbing work without required plumbing licensure or apprenticeship registration.

Mark Healy, Amston, CT – (SP-1) Limited Spa/Pool Contractor – Approved (SP-2)

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Healy's (SP-1) Limited Spa/Pool Contractor application due to lack of a required (SP-2) Limited Spa/Pool Journeyperson license for a minimum of two years. After further review of Mr. Healy's application, the Board voted unanimously to approve him to sit for the (SP-2) Limited Spa/Pool Journeyperson examination based on equivalent experience and training. If he successfully passes the (SP-2) Limited Spa/Pool Journeyperson examination, he may apply for the (SP-1) Limited Spa/Pool Contractor license and appear before the Board to request a hardship waiver of the two year requirement as an (SP-2) Limited Spa/Pool Journeyperson license holder.

Rocco T. Lauretti, Jr., Southington, CT – (P-6) Limited Journeyperson – Denied The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Lauretti's application due to lack of a required "Apprenticeship Completion Certificate".

Moises Ortiz-Pastor, Ossining, NY – (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – Denied The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Ortiz-Pastor's application due to lack of required occupational school related instruction experience.

Christopher Pinto, Darien, CT – (SP-1) Limited Spa and Pool Contractor – No Action Mr. Pinto did not appear today and the Board took no action.

Keith Regan, Pelham, NH – (P-1) Unlimited Contractor – No Action Mr. Regan did not appear today and the Board took no action.

John Rees, Meriden, CT – (P-6) Limited Journeyperson – Denied
The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Rees' application due to lack of a required
"Apprenticeship Completion Certificate".

Peter Sizensky, Stamford, CT – (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – Withdrawn Mr. Sizensky withdrew his application for future filing.

David Surprenant, Jr., Enfield, CT – (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – Approved The Board voted unanimously to approve Mr. Surprenant's application.

Randy Vachon, Westminster, MA – (P-7) Limited Contractor – Denied
The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Vachon's application due to lack of a required
(P-6) Limited Journeyperson license for a minimum of two years.

Michael Vengruskas, Ellington, CT – (SP-1) Limited Spa/Pool Contractor – Approved (SP-2) The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Vengruskas' (SP-1) Limited Spa/Pool Contractor application due to lack of a required (SP-2) Limited Spa/Pool Journeyperson license for a minimum of two years. After further review of Mr. Vengruskas' application, the Board voted unanimously to approve him to sit for the (SP-2) Limited Spa/Pool Journeyperson examination based on equivalent experience and training. If he successfully passes the (SP-2) Limited Spa/Pool Journeyperson examination, he may apply for the (SP-1) Limited Spa/Pool Contractor license and appear before the Board to request a hardship waiver of the two year requirement as an (SP-2) Limited Spa/Pool Journeyperson license holder.

DRAFT REGULATION CONCERNING AERATION PIPING SYSTEM WORK

The Board unanimously requested that the hearing officer handling the draft regulation concerning Aeration Piping System Work be made aware of the Board's previous opinions at their August 21, 2008, December 17, 2009, and March 21, 2011 meeting, in which the Board unanimously concluded that the scope of work concerning the installation of Aeration Piping System Work falls under the jurisdiction of CT General Statutes, Chapter 393, requiring a (P-1) Unlimited Contractor or (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson license only, including sludge and all associated equipment.
