Mr. Kazemekas appeared to request that an exemption to Connecticut Well Drilling laws be granted due to a hardship. The current well on this property is not producing sufficient water supply. Due to the small size of the property, there is limited space in which to drill a new well and accommodate the equipment required to do such. The homeowner has received a proposal to drill a new well. The proposed location for the new well is 69 feet away from the septic systems at 10 and 11 Cedar Avenue therefore it does NOT meet the 75 foot requirement of distance between the two.

After discussion, the Board requested that Mr. Kazemekas submit the proposal he has received from the licensed well driller to the Department for review. Upon receipt of this document, the Department may grant the hardship as requested.
