Instructions for Locksmith Registration

Definitions

• **"Locksmith"** means the inspection, installation, recombination, rekeying service or repair of locks or locking devices.

Application Fee:

• A check or money order in the amount of <u>\$200.00</u> made payable to "Treasurer, State of Connecticut" must accompany the completed application. The fee is non-refundable or non-transferable. Once approved, locksmith registrations are non-transferable or assignable. All registrations expire biennially on December 31st of every even-numbered year.

Criminal Records Check:

- The following documentation <u>must be attached and submitted with the application</u>. Do not submit the application until you are able to provide these record checks.
 - 1. A Criminal History Record report from the State of Connecticut, State Police Bureau of Identification, 1111 Country Club Rd., Middletown, CT 06457. The form is available at http://www.ct.gov/despp
- 2. A Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Identification Record/Criminal Background Check. Information can be obtained at <u>https://www.fbi.gov/services/cjis/identity-history-summary-checks</u>

Exemptions:

- The following persons shall be exempt from registration as a locksmith, but only if the person performing the service does not hold himself or herself out to the public as a locksmith:
 - A) persons employed by a state, municipality or other political subdivision, or by any agency or department of the government of the United States, acting in their official capacity;
 - B) automobile service dealers who service, install, repair or rebuild automobile locks;
 - C) retail merchants selling locks or similar security accessories or installing, programming, repairing, maintaining, reprogramming, rebuilding or servicing electronic garage door devices;
 - D) members of the building trades who install or remove complete locks or locking devices in the course of residential or commercial new construction or remodeling;
 - E) employees of towing services, repossessors, or an automobile club representative or employee opening automotive locks in the normal course of his or her business. The provisions of this section shall not prohibit an employee of a towing service from opening motor vehicles to enable a vehicle to be moved without towing, provided the towing service does not hold itself out to the public, by directory advertisement, through a sign at the facilities of the towing service or by any other form of advertisement, as a locksmith;
 - F) students in a course of study in locks mith programs approved by the department;
 - $G) \quad warranty\ services\ by\ a\ lock\ manufacturer\ or\ its\ employees\ on\ the\ manufacturer's\ own\ products;$
 - H) maintenance employees of a property owner or property management companies at multifamily residential buildings, who service, install, repair or open locks for tenants;
 - I) persons employed as security personnel at schools or institutions of higher education who open locks while acting in the course of their employment.
