The SHPO awarded Hurricane Sandy disaster relief funds to the Greenwich Historical Society for the rehabilitation of a residence at 39 Strickland Road in the Cos Cob section of Greenwich. The project included the replacement of a slate tile roof as well as copper gutters, flashing, and downspouts.

The house at 39 Strickland Road (a.k.a. the Magdalene Brucker House) was built in 1934 and is a well-preserved example of a vernacular Tudor Revival residence, with brick and stucco walls, slate roof, copper flashings, and gutters. The house, a rental property owned by the Greenwich Historical Society at the time of Hurricane Sandy, is a contributing structure in the National Register-listed Strickland Road Historic District.
