## **FINAL DECISION**

I conducted a hearing today regarding the suspension of the hunting license held by the above-listed respondent. General Statutes §22a-62. Following a review of the record in this matter, including the testimony of Sgt. Chis Dwyer and the respondent and comment on the record from the shooting victim, I concur that the hunting related shooting that was the basis of this action was accidental. Furthermore, the respondent sincerely expressed that the incident has made him more aware and cautious as a hunter. I therefore adopt the recommendation of Sgt. Dwyer and find that the license of Mr. Sager will *not be suspended*.
