



Directions:

From the East: Take I-95 South. Take the Route I35/ North Benson Road exit 22 and continue 0.15 miles. Turn left onto North Benson Road/ Route I35 and continue 0.22 miles. Turn right onto Boston Post Road/ US-I and continue 0.21 miles. Turn right onto South Benson Road which runs into Jennings Beach. At the stop sign merge to the left at the fork. Follow this road and the entrance to Jennings Beach will be on the right.

From the West: Take I-95 North. Take the Mill Plain Road exit 21 and continue 0.21 miles. Turn right onto Mill Plain Road and continue 0.19 miles. Turn left onto Boston Post Road/ US-1 and continue 0.38 miles. Turn right onto South Benson Road which runs into Jennings Beach. At the stop sign merge to the left at the fork. Follow this road and the entrance to Jennings Beach will be on the right.
