Underlying Principles of RSR Amendments

- LEP-Implementation
 - DEEP involvement not required where it was required before
- Building on DEEP Experience
 - Responding to situations where sites may have been stuck – e.g., pesticides, roadways
- Adding Predictability/Clarification
 - Making clearer what a requirements, how rules apply
 - Facilitate better evaluation of costs
- Flexibility
 - Providing additional options to achieve compliance
- Protection of Human Health and the Environment
 - The baseline that must be met








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
