### Spent Materials

#### <u>Used towels</u>

- Listed non specific source HW (261.31)
  - Not listed



- Characteristic HW (261.21 24)
  - Benzalkonium chloride, trichlosan, thyme oil based products
    - No RCRA characteristics
  - Alcohol based products **D001**
    - Ignitable (FP less than 140)

» 100 deg. F

(pass paint filter test - not D001)

## Containers with content and spills

- Listed commercial chemical products HW (261.33)
  - Not listed
- Characteristic HW (261.21 24)
  - Benzalkonium chloride, trichlosan, thyme oil based products
    - No RCRA characteristics
  - Alcohol based products **D001** 
    - Ignitable (flash point less than 140)
      - 77 deg. F for liquid
      - 89 deg. F for lotion
      - 100 deg. F for towels
  - Aerosols **D001** 
    - Flammable gas

### Scrap Metal

Empty Metal Containers

(provided no acutely hazardous materials)

- Scrap metal recycling
  - Recycling #1 and 2 plastic



#1 and #2 empty plastic containers are recyclable
