Effective & Sustainable Materials Management

Formal Action: Consent order issued January 14, 2019

- 1. Respondents failed to provide for and cause the separation of mandatory recyclables.
- 2. Eight multi-tenant housing locations (New Haven & New Britain).
- 3. Several individual limited liability companies and one managing member (linked to all LLCs).



Effective & Sustainable Materials Management

Consent order (January 14, 2019): Corrective Measures

- Identify all multi-tenant housing locations in Connecticut owned, operated or managed by Respondents.
- 2. Establish appropriate recycling programs at all such locations.
- 3. Develop and administer a comprehensive outreach and education program for all tenants.
- 4. Hire an independent qualified consultant to visually inspect such locations following program implementation to verify that each such location is fully compliant with Connecticut Recycling Law.
- 5. Payment of a \$9,945 Civil Penalty.
