



Focus Group Themes

- Want visually appealing signs
 - Photographs
 - Not much text
 - Big
 - At eye level
 - **Location-specific** materials
- Recycling signs: want **blue** and **recycling symbol**
- **Trash sign** preferred to list of "don't recycle" on recycling sign
- Stickers preferred to posters


