## RULING RE: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO SUBMIT LATE FILE EXHIBITS

On December 8, 2015, Cedarhurst Association, Inc. ("Cedarhurst") filed with the Department of Public Health and the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's Public Utility Regulatory Authority (jointly "Departments") a request for an extension of time until December 14, 2015, to submit late file exhibits ("Request"). In support of the Request, Cedarhurst stated that it has not yet received information from both a vendor regarding the costs to install and operate treatment to address Cedarhurst's lead exceedance and the town of Newtown regarding well permits. The late file exhibits are due on or before December 9, 2015.

The Departments hereby **GRANT** the Request. Accordingly, Cedarhurst shall submit late file exhibits no later than **December 14, 2015, by 4:00 p.m**.
