Section II



- ESA boundaries may only be established or modified at a properly noticed WUCC meeting (agenda and maps published 14 days in advance)
- Quorum must be present per Bylaws
- Provisions for conflicts of interest for WUCC Officers



Section III – Assignment of Initial ESAs



- Public water systems maintain existing service areas
- No new service areas or extensions which create duplication or overlap of services
- Discusses Declaration Forms, Meetings, Public Comment
- Assignment requires a majority vote
- Encourages declarants to come to resolution
- Conflict resolution procedures
 - Presentations / Scoring Rubric
 - Alternatives
 - Vote on a proposal or send to mediation
 - PURA recommendation
 - o DPH assignment
 - o Appeals

- Section IV Modification of ESAs
 - Type A Modification Between Two ESA Holders
 - Type B Modification Due to Creation of New Public Water System
 - Type C Modification Due to Appeal
 - Type D Modification Due to Other Reasons

Note: Presentations by each declarant will address the seven specific exclusive service area boundary considerations as outlined in Section 25-33h-1(d)(B)(ii) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. See declaration form for more detail on the issues considered under each item. THIS FORM IS FOR USE BY WUCC MEMBERS AS GUIDANCE TO HELP INFORM THAT MEMBER'S EVENTUAL VOTE ON A CONFLICTED AREA. IT WILL NOT BE HANDED INTO THE WUCC OR DISTRIBUTED PUBLICALLY.

Ratings are scored as follows:

1 = Unsuited; 2 = Poorly Suited; 3 = Moderately Suited; 4 = Well Suited; and 5 = Very Well Suited





Changes to the posted agenda for conflict resolution


- Litchfield Resolution underway; need more time

Town of Litchfield



- The Aquarion Water Company, CT DEEP, and the Torrington Water company have all claimed exclusive service areas in Litchfield, which is in conflict with the town's desire to remain unassigned.
- Aquarion operates its Litchfield system throughout the center of town.
- CT DEEP operates a TNC at Topsmead State Park
- Torrington Water Company serves a small area in the northeast corner of town.







Town of New Hartford



- Aquarion, CT DEEP, New Hartford Water Pollution Control Authority, and TWC, have all made ESA declarations in New Hartford.
- The New Hartford Water Pollution Control Authority operates a community water system in the northeast corner of town. Torrington Water Company serves a small areas in the southwest corner of town.
- CT DEEP and Aquarion do not own or operate any public water systems in New Hartford.







ESA Conflict Presentations for 2/14/17
