### **Certified Backflow Preventer Device Tester**

Once a person has completed and passed such a course the Application for Certification must be completed and returned to the DPH within one year after the date of the most recent exam results (i.e. date of initial NEWWA certificate issuance). This certification is issued based on having substantiated compliance with the minimum requirements (i.e. completed and passed CT DPH approved training course on the testing of backflow prevention devices) specified in the Regulation of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA), Sec. 25-32-11(e). The following course(s) have been approved by the CT DPH:

Course Title: "Training and Certification of Backflow Prevention Device Inspectors"  
*Student must pass the written and practical exams and must be in attendance for the 1 Hr. Presentation on CT Cross Connection Control Regulations*

Course Provider: New England Water Works Association (NEWWA)  
Contact Hours: 20 hours (2.0 CEUs)

Public Water Systems shall have annual tests performed on specific testable backflow prevention devices (i.e. reduced pressure principle backflow preventer, double check valve assembly and pressure vacuum breaker) that exist at their customers locations, as specified by RCSA Section 19-13-B38a.(f)(7).

A "Backflow Prevention Device Tester" is certified to perform tests on testable backflow prevention devices, as determined by the Public Water System, to comply with the above cited regulation.

### **Certified Cross Connection Survey Inspector**

Once a person has completed and passed such a course the Application for Certification must be completed and returned to the DPH within one year after the date of the most recent exam results (i.e. date of initial NEWWA certificate issuance). The certification has been issued based on having substantiated compliance with the minimum requirements (i.e. completed and passed CT DPH approved training course on cross connection inspections) specified in the Regulation of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA), Sec. 25-32-11(h). The following course(s) have been approved by the CT DPH:

Course Title: "Cross Connection Surveyor Training"  
*Student must pass the written exam*

Public Water Systems shall have inspections for cross connections performed on the premises of customers where certain categories of concern are known to exist, as specified by RCSA Section 19-13-B102(f).
