In accordance with Connecticut General Statutes Section 25-33h, the Central Connecticut Water Utility Coordinating Committee (WUCC) has prepared the attached Final Integrated Report and Final Executive Summary for the Central Connecticut Public Water Supply Management Area. These documents, together with the previously submitted Final Water Supply Assessment (December 2016) and the Final Exclusive Service Area Boundary document (June 2017) comprise the Coordinated Public Water System Plan for the Central Region. This submission concludes the two-year planning process that commenced in June of 2016.

We are pleased to report that the participation of Central Region WUCC members has been robust and was maintained for the duration of the two-year process. At our June 4, 2018 meeting, the attending members re-elected officers Radka, Halloran, and Avery, along with an additional Chair, Mr. Vincent J. Tursi, II, a member of the Tolland Water Commission. Moving forward, Mr. Tursi will serve as tri-chair of the Central WUCC, along with the undersigned. Our next meeting is scheduled to take place on Wednesday, October 17, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. at the MDC Training Center, 125 Maxim Road, Hartford, CT. It is our intent to hold meetings at least three times per year (every four months), or as may be necessary to properly conduct business to come before the WUCC.
