

LEGAL NOTICE

Section 677(b) of Public Act 17-2 (June Spec. Sess) (“the Public Act”) required the Commissioner of Public Health (“Commissioner”), in consultation with the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management and representatives of water companies, to develop a methodology for a safe drinking water primacy assessment on community water systems and noncommunity public water systems for the purposes of meeting federal requirements for the Department of Public Health (“the DPH”) to maintain primacy for the enforcement of the federal Safe Drinking Water Act. Following the development of such methodology, the Commissioner is required to provide for a public comment period of thirty days. The Commissioner has developed a methodology and, pursuant to section 677(b) of the Public Act, hereby provides notice that such methodology is available for public comment.
