All training must be approved pursuant to the Water Supplies Section's *Guidance Document for Operator Certification Training Approval*

All training must be completed within the three year renewal cycle

- 1 Continuing Education Unit (CEU) = 10 training hours
- 1 college credit = 15 training hours

Example 1: A Class I Water Treatment Plant Operator has a certificate that expires on July 1, 2004. He or she must obtain 7 hours of approved training during the period of July 1, 2001 to July 1, 2004. The same operator will need 10 hours to renew on July 1, 2007.

Example 2: A Class III Distribution System Operator has a certificate that expires on January 1, 2003. He or she must obtain 10 hours of approved training during the period of January 1, 2000 to January 1, 2003. The same operator will need 30 hours to renew on January 1, 2006.
