Which EMS agency responded to the call? Were lights and sirens were used?

Performance measures that use this data include AIRWAY, CARDIAC ARREST, PEDIATRIC, RESPONSE, STEMI, STROKE and TRAUMA.

TIP: Do NOT use free text to enter your agency ID. It should be one group of characters, always entered the same way or automatically part of an open ePCR. Verify your agency id!!

Type of Service Requested is crucial. Unit identifications, response mode and level of care are also Mandatory. Unit and agency identifiers should not be free texted.
