The "Notification of Asbestos Abatement" form is to be completed and post marked or hand delivered to the Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) at least ten (10) days prior to the start of asbestos abatement, as required by the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, Section 19a-332a-3. In case of an emergency\*, this form is to be completed and post marked within one (1) working day following the start of asbestos abatement. Initial notifications may not be faxed.

\*For facilities that are regulated by the US EPA under the federal asbestos NESHAP, please review the guidance document issued by the EPA Region 1 regarding less than ten day (emergency) renovations and demolitions. Please contact the DPH for case by case review.

**Notification fee** for abatement of >25 Square Feet (SF) up to 160 Square Feet (SF) of asbestos-containing material is \$100, payable to "Treasurer, State of Connecticut". Additional fee of 1% of the total abatement cost is due for projects involving 160 SF or more.

If demolition is to follow abatement, a separate demolition form is not required.

**Revised notifications** may be faxed in or emailed to DPH.Asbestos@ct.gov and notification should be in the "active" status. If an additional fee is due, please provide a hard copy with the check payment.

## ABATEMENT IN SCHOOLS (K-12)

The "Asbestos Containing Materials in Schools" regulation (section 19a-333-1 through 19a-333-13 ) prohibits asbestos abatement while school is in session without prior written consent from the Department. The DPH requests verification that no child will be present during asbestos abatement, in the form of email or letter from the local education agency or its consultant stating the dates of abatement, materials to be abated, quantities and locations of abatement, contractor name, project designer name and project monitor name with the notification form. Approval to conduct abatement while school is in session is only granted by the DPH under specific guidelines and approval must be in writing.

Typed forms are appreciated. Otherwise, please ensure form is legible.



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
