

## Section 19-13-B100a (a) Definitions

\*Building conversion: the act of winterizing a seasonal use building into year round use by providing one or more of the following:

- \*a positive heating supply to the converted area
- \*a potable water supply which is protected from freezing

\*energy conservation in the form of insulation to protect from heat loss

## \*Section 19-13-B100a (a) Definitions


\*Change in use: any structural, mechanical or physical change to a building which allows the occupancy to increase \*Or activities within a building that


expand or alter it such that, when the building is fully utilized, <u>the design flow</u> or required effective leaching area will increase

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\*Code complying area: an <u>area</u> on a property where a subsurface sewage disposal system can be installed which meets <u>all</u> requirements of PHC Section 19-13-B103, <u>except</u> for the one hundred percent reserve leaching area.

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\*Technical Standards: those standards established by the Commissioner of Public Health in the most recent revision of the publication entitled "Technical Standards for Subsurface Sewage Disposal Systems" prepared pursuant to Section 19-13-B103d (d) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies

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
