Note: The CDC ELITE Program does not evaluate performance of molecular (e.g., PCR), serological (e.g., DFA), or rapid analytical tests (e.g., dipstick) because methods other than culture are not discriminating enough to be applied as a primary test to environmental samples. These other methods are suitable for supplemental testing only. This is a voluntary proficiency testing program and the ELITE Program only assesses laboratories in their ability to isolate culturable *Legionella* from water samples. ELITE member labs must correctly identify proficiency samples sent to them twice per year and are provided a certificate of performance for their efforts.
