Get out of the house and get medical help right away if you or a family member have signs of carbon monoxide poisoning. Signs include headache, fatigue, dizziness, nausea, vomiting or loss of consciousness. Call 9-1-1 from a cell phone outside of your home or from a neighbor's home.
