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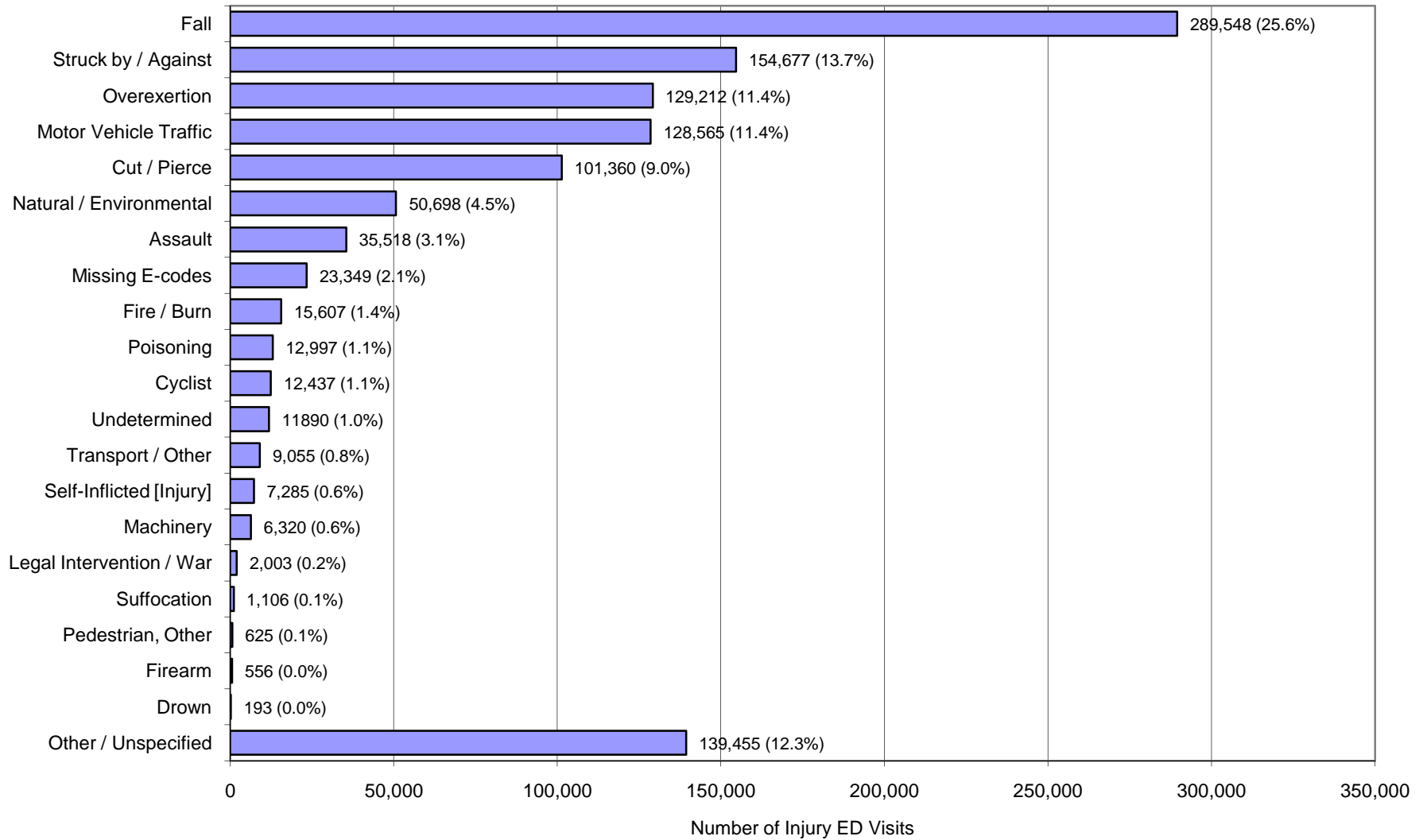

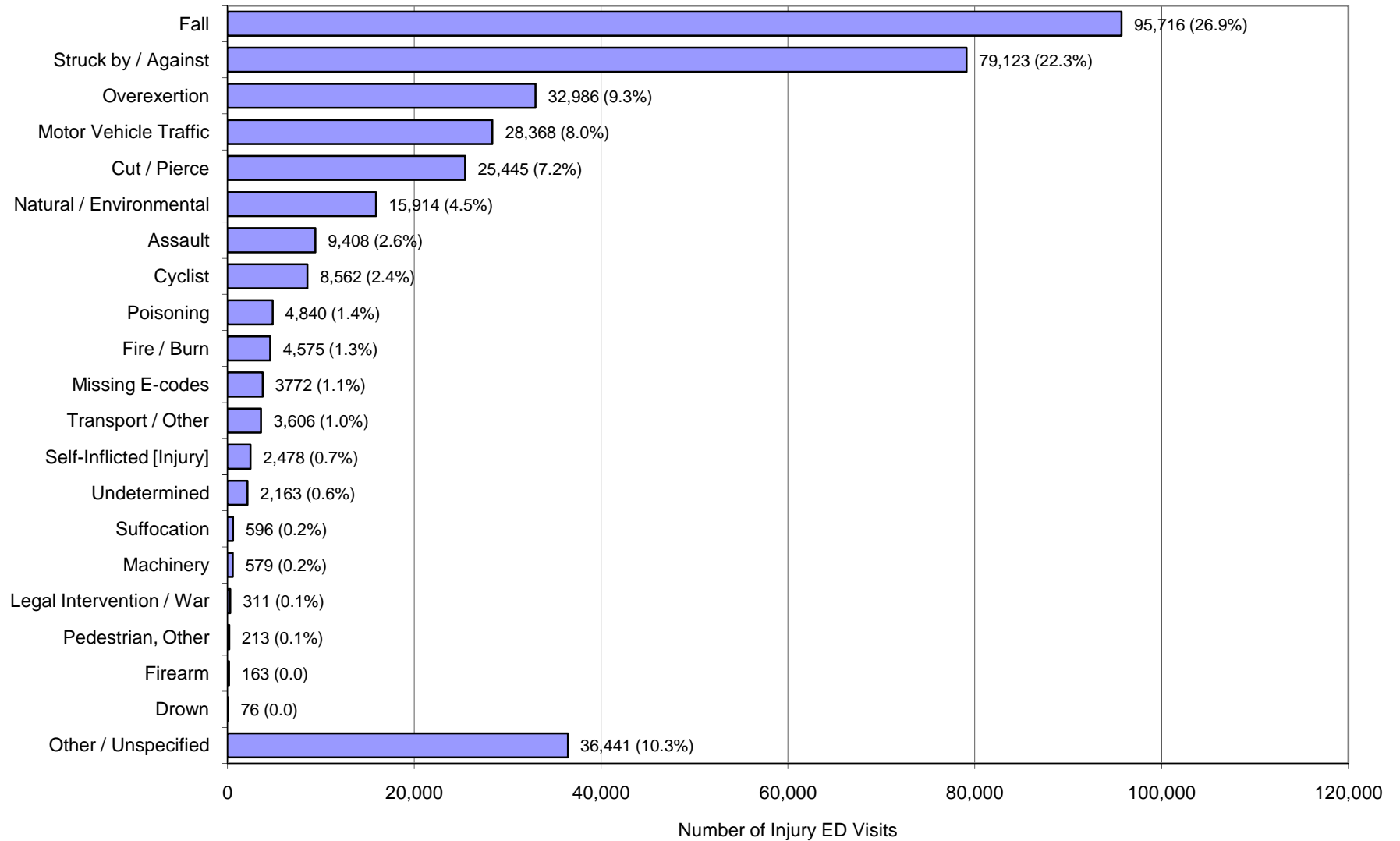

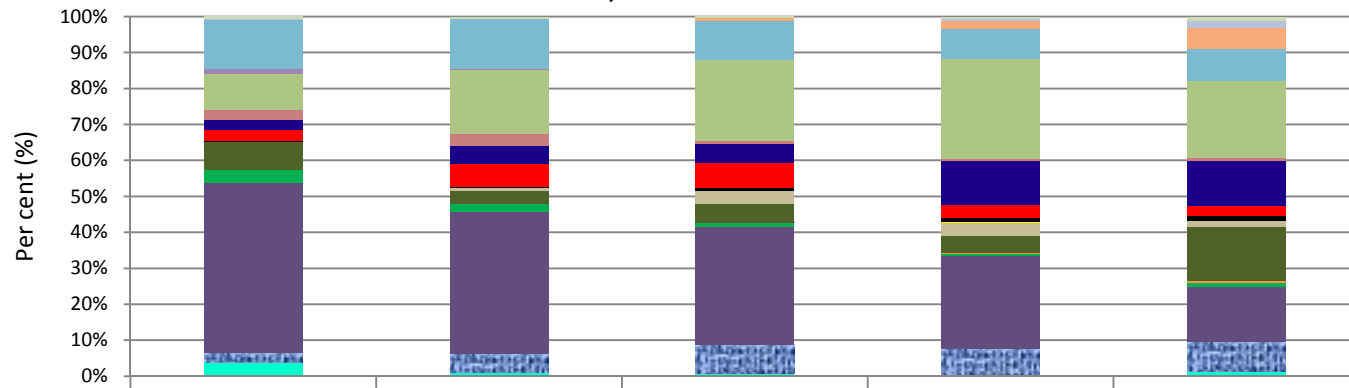
Leading Causes of Injury* ED Visits

(n = 355,335; Average = 118,445/year)

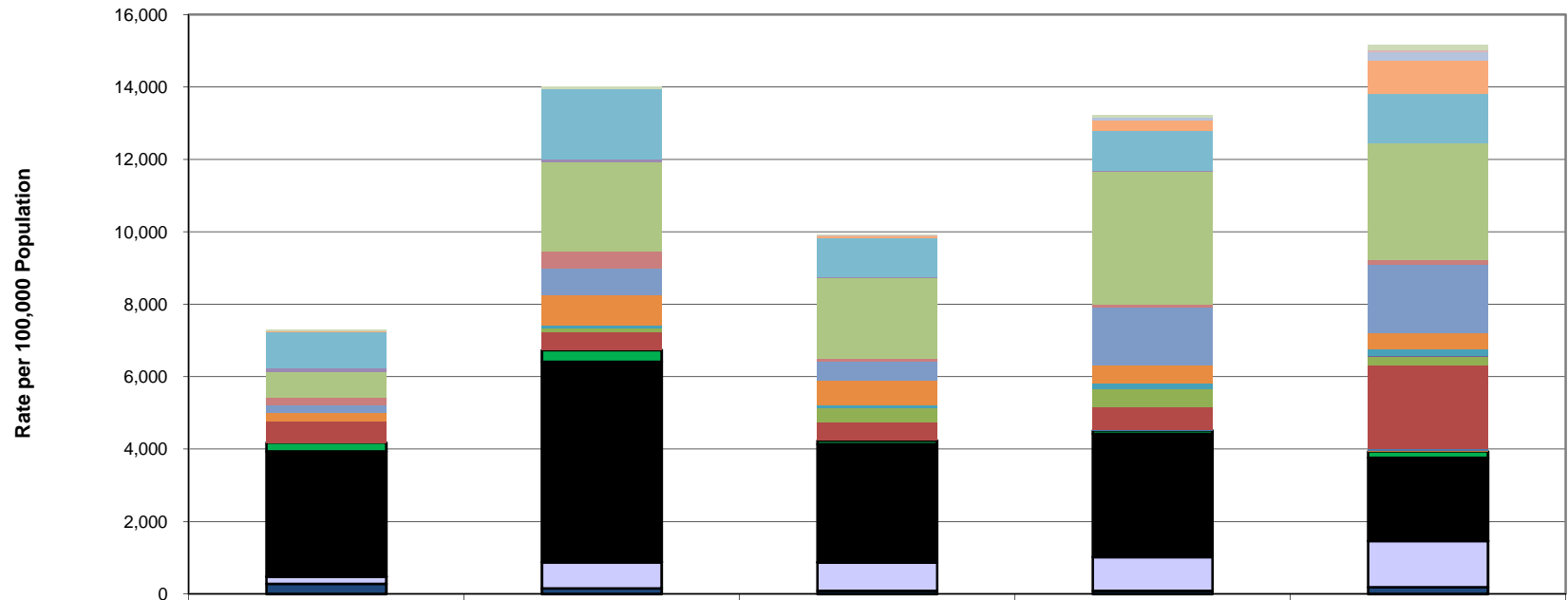

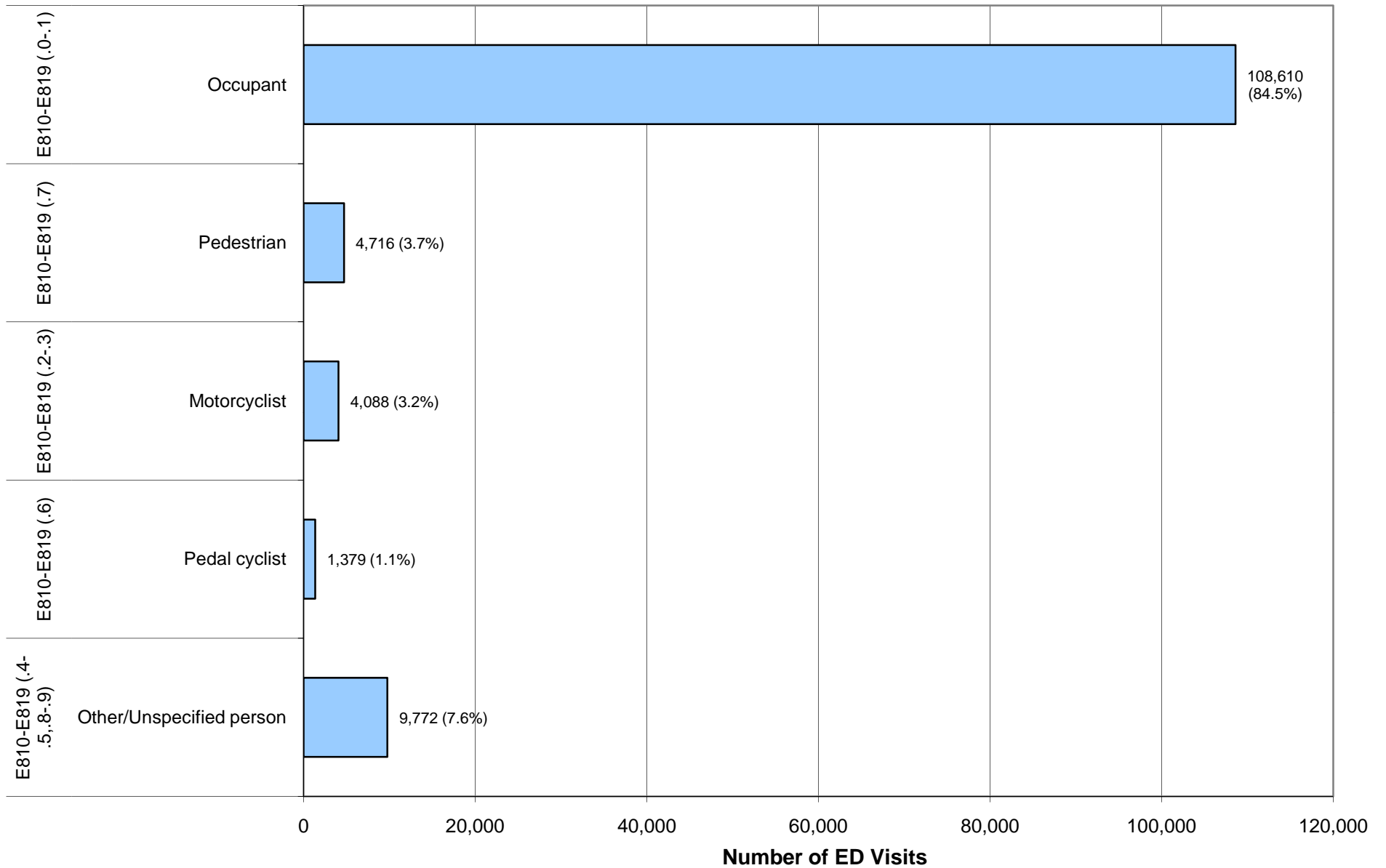

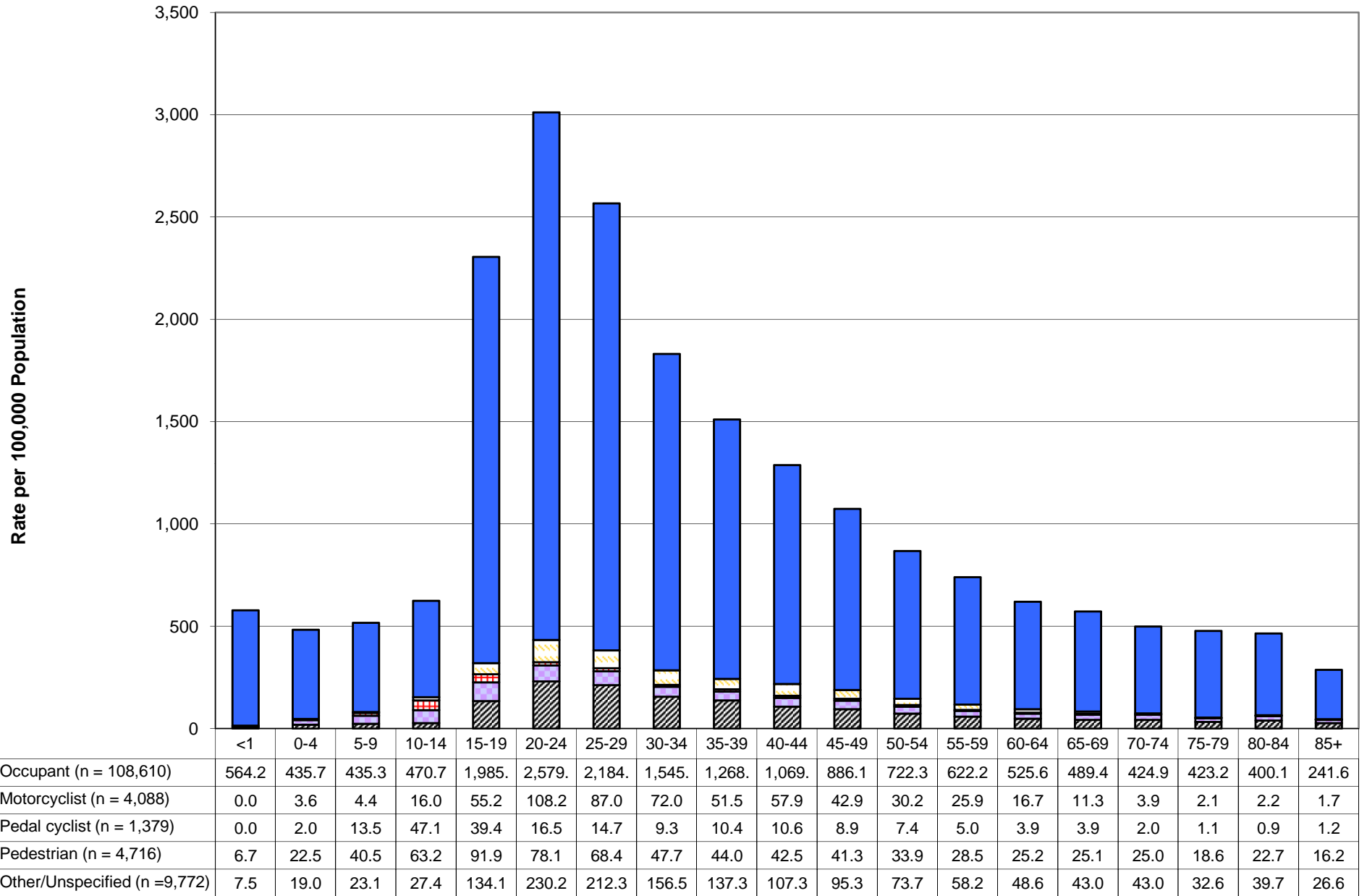
Unintentional Motor Vehicle Traffic* ED Visits by Person Injured

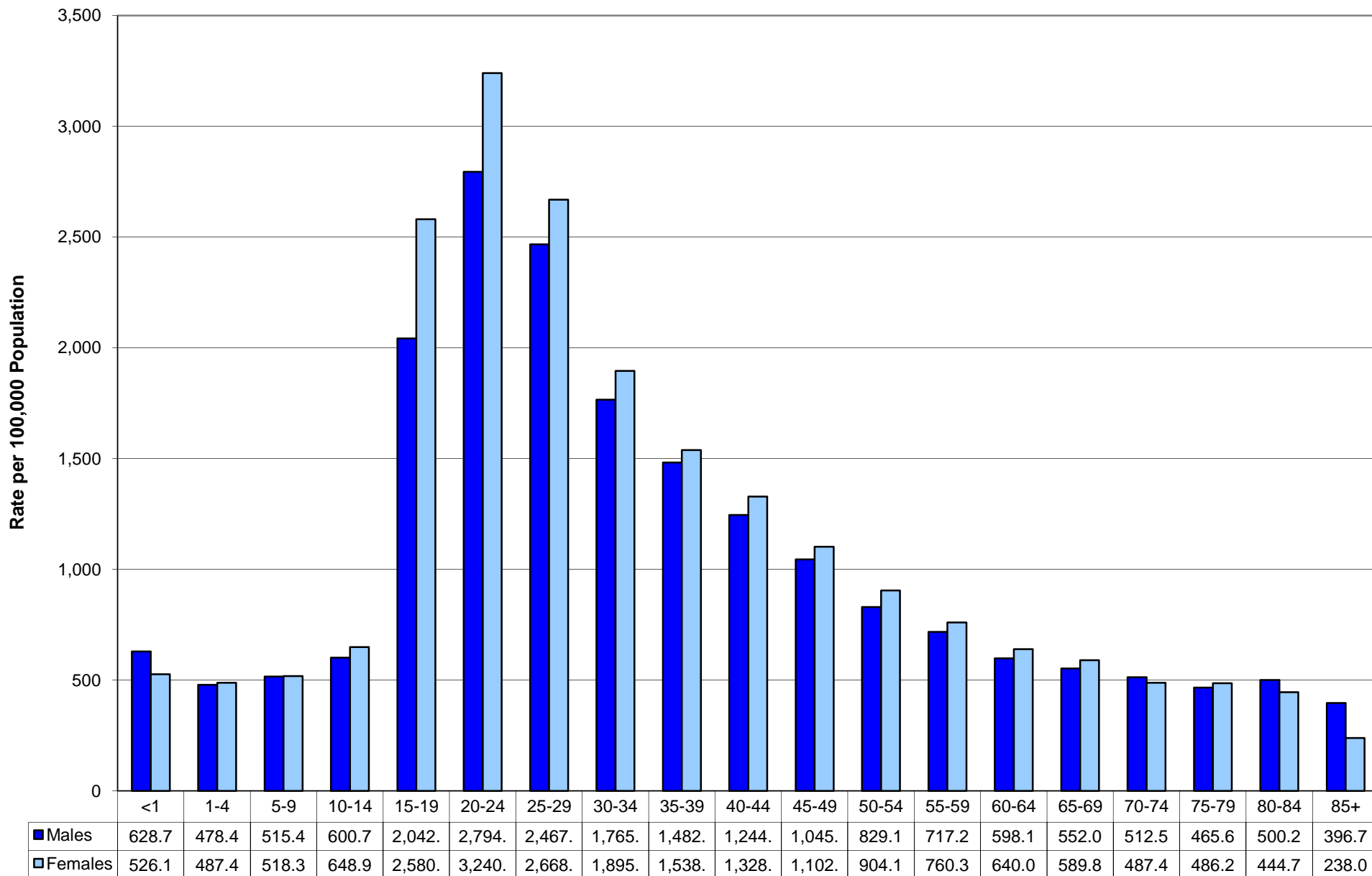

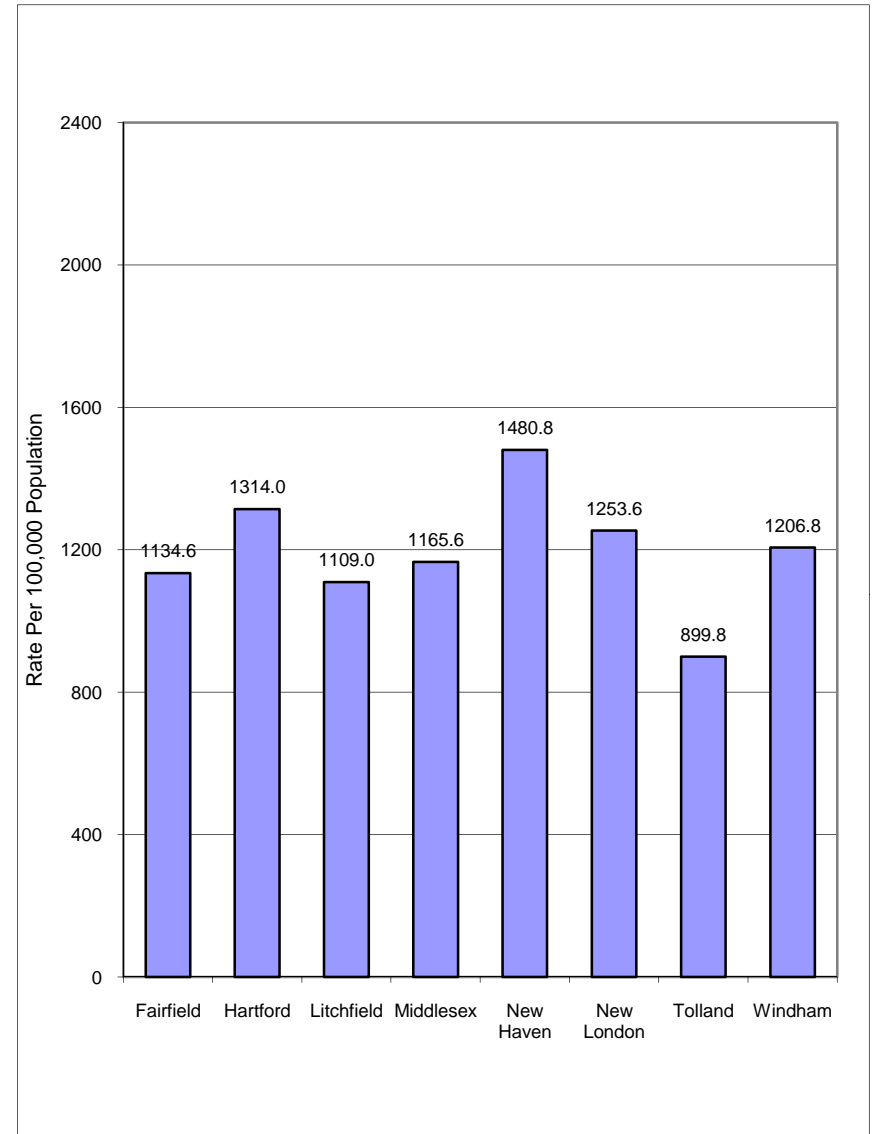
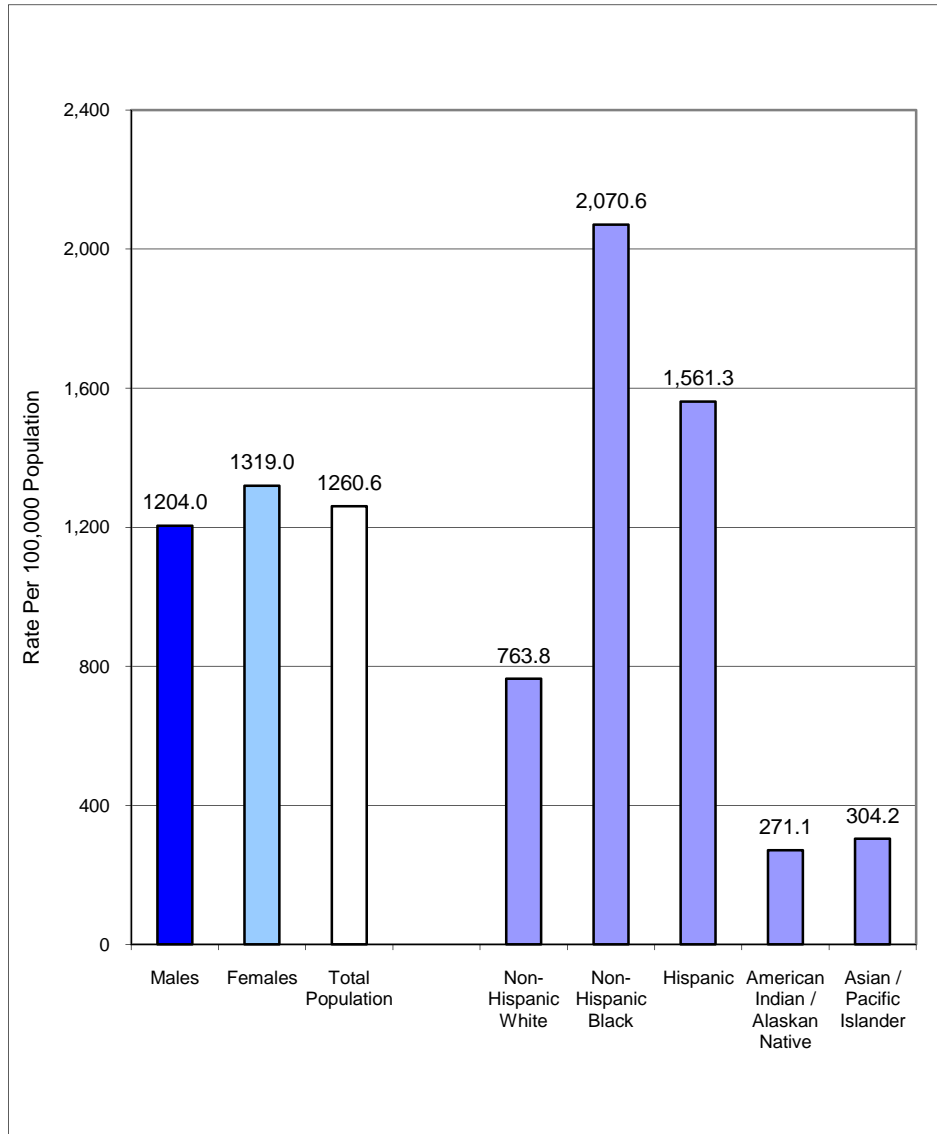
Motor Vehicle Traffic ED Visit Rates by Person Injured & Age Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007



Motor Vehicle Traffic ED Visit Rates By Age & Sex Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007



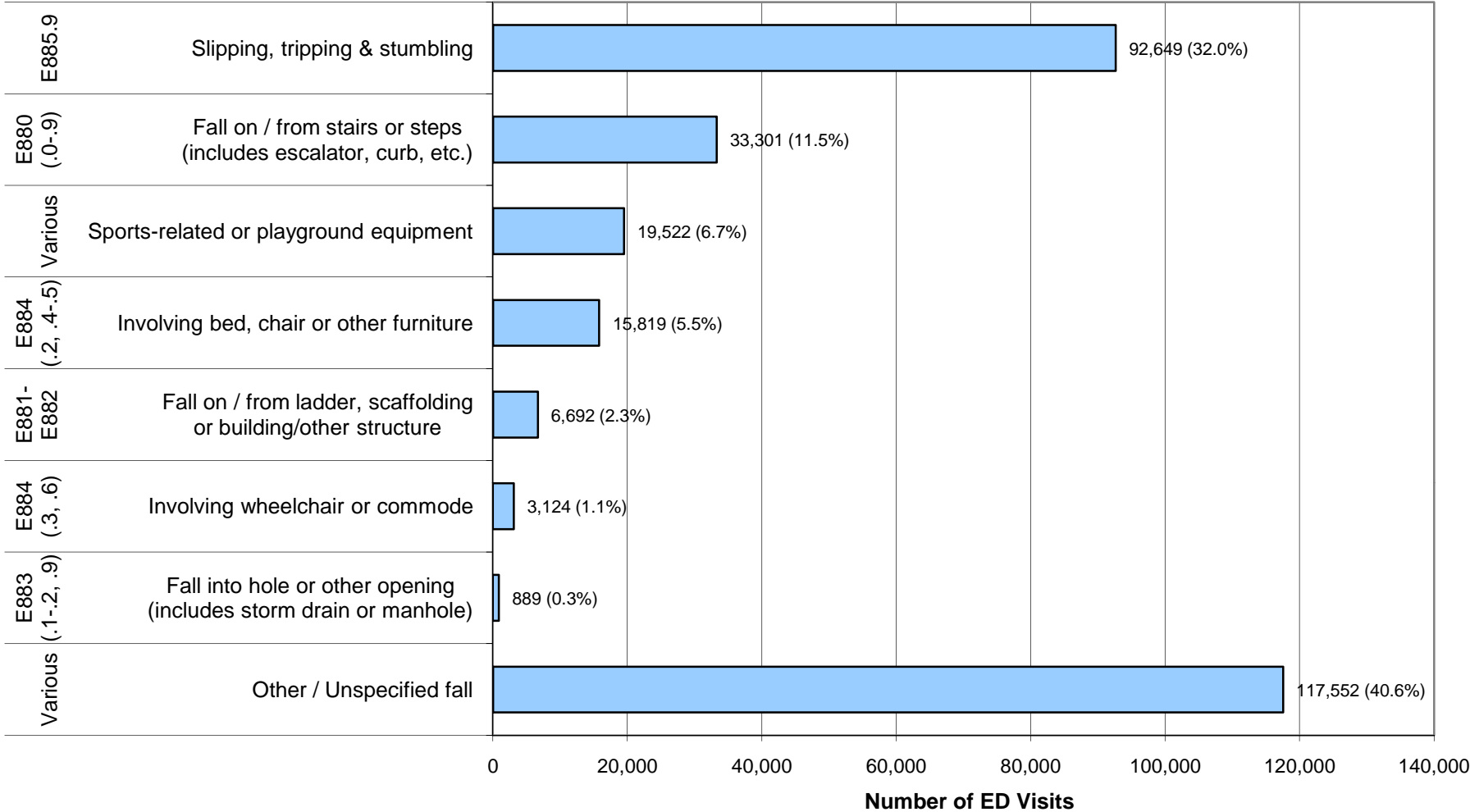

Unintentional Fall* ED Visits By Mechanism

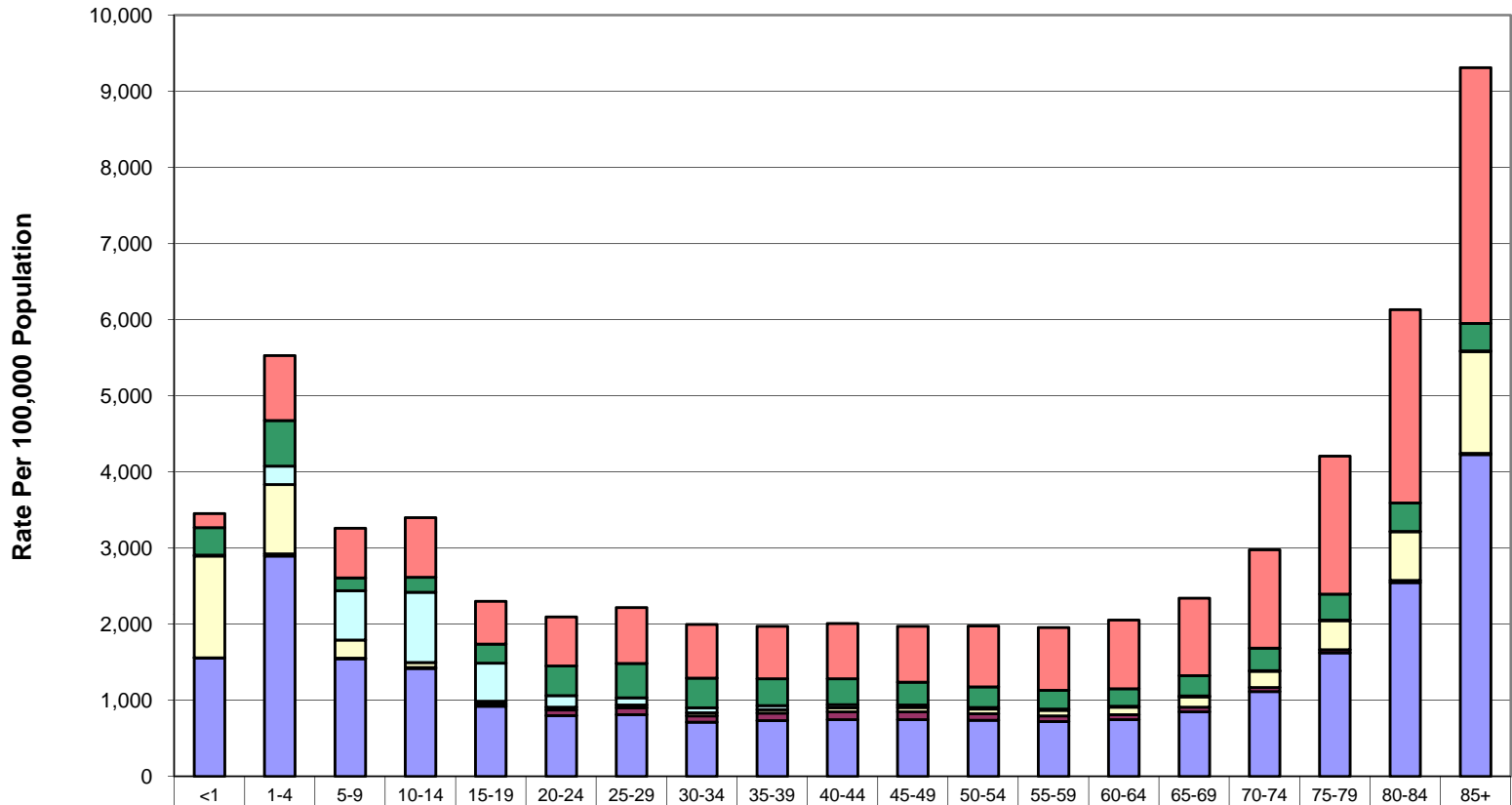

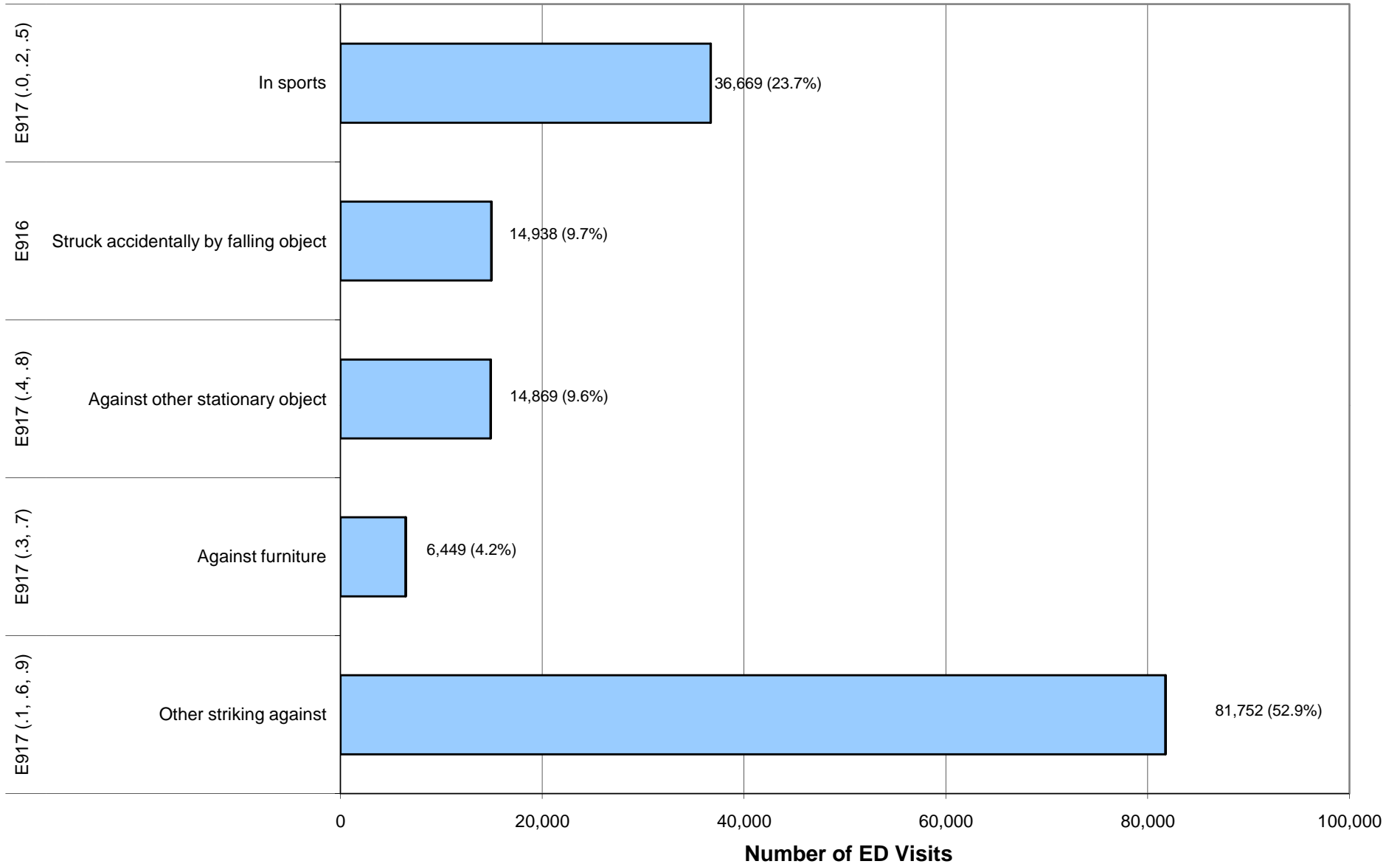
Fall ED Visit Rates By Age & Sex Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007



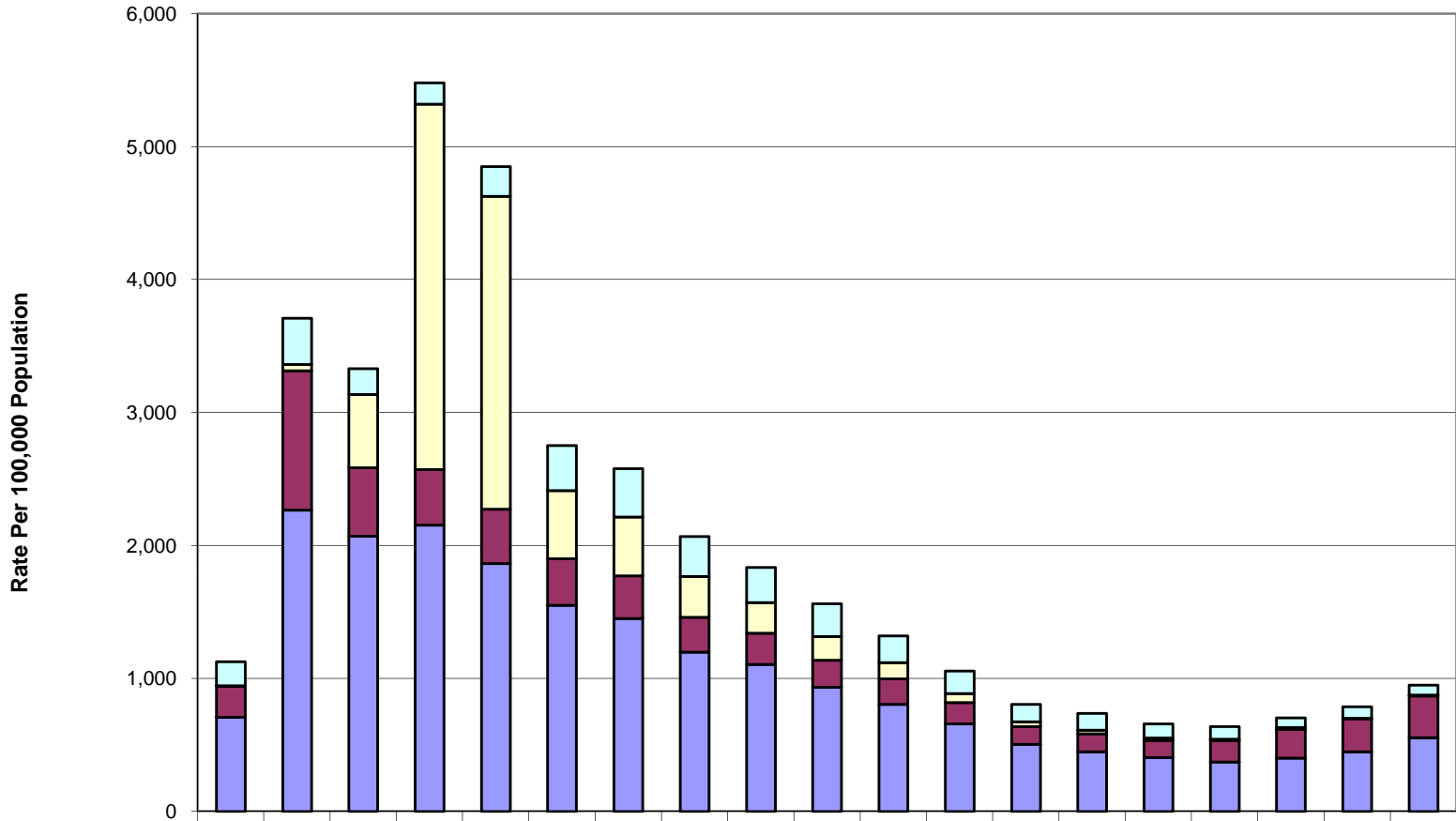
Age-Adjusted Fall ED Visit Rates by Sex, Race/Ethnicity & County of Residence Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007

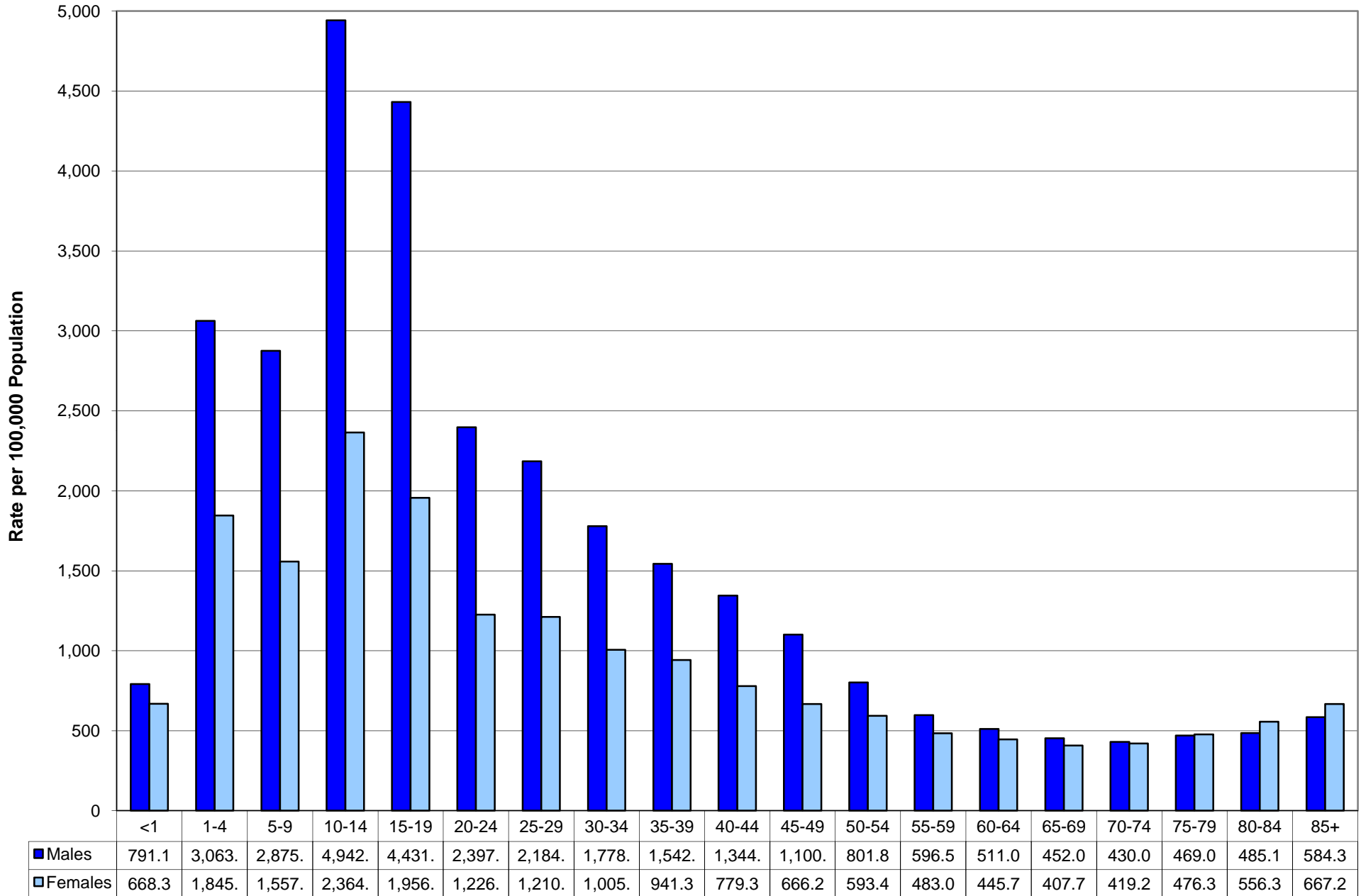

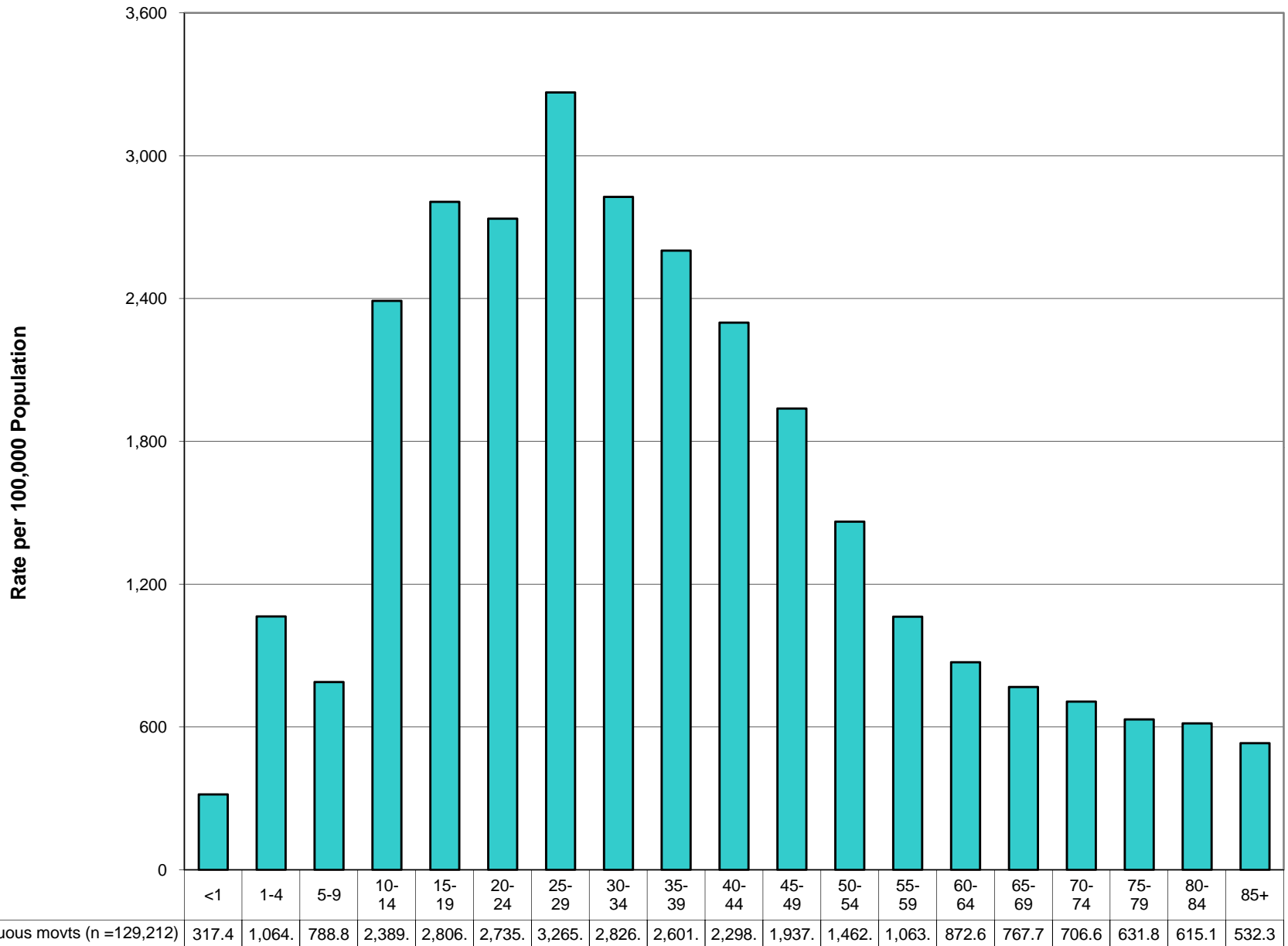
Struck by / Against ED Visit Rates by Age & Sex Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007

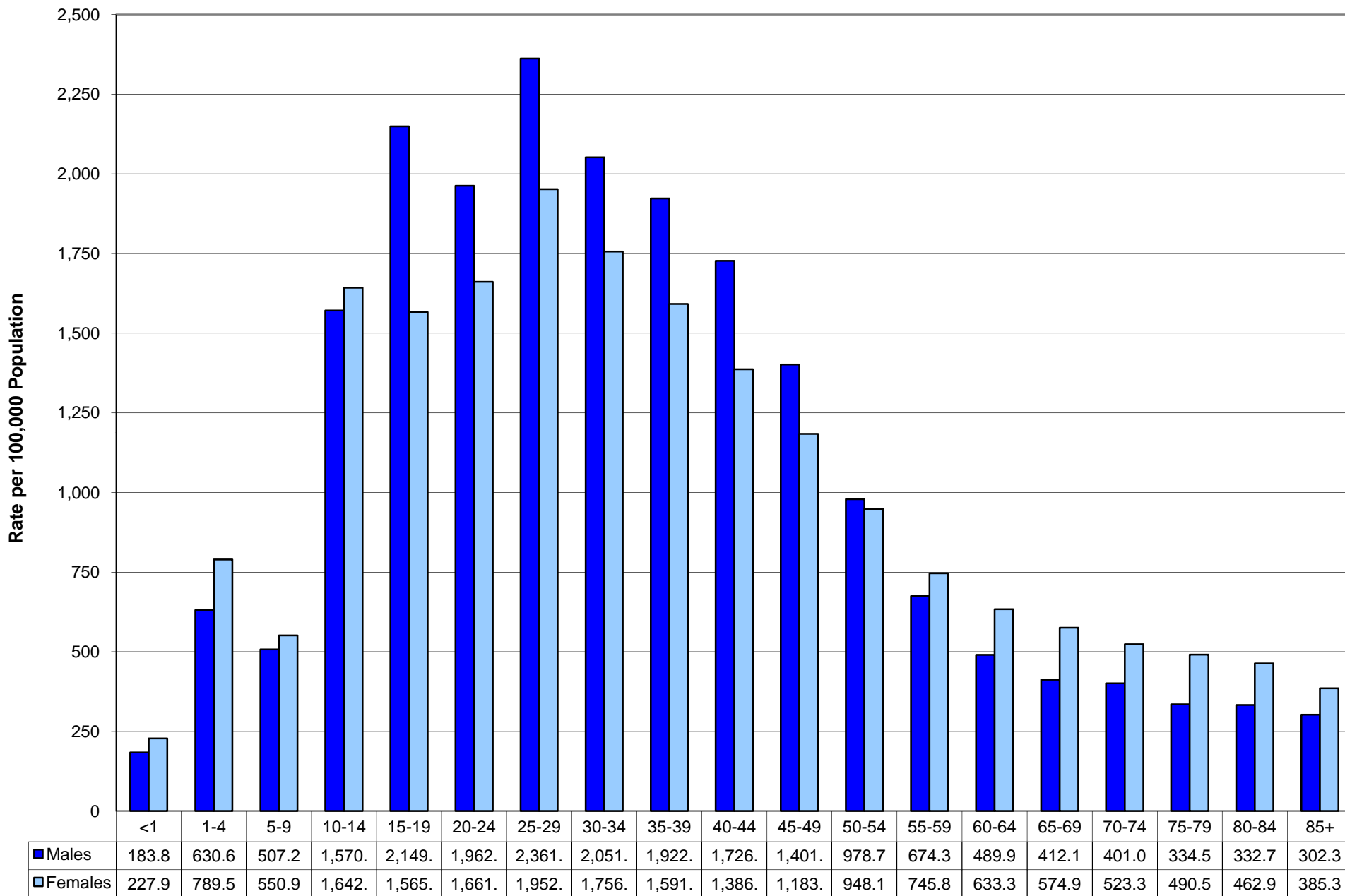


Unintentional Overexertion* ED Visit Rates by Mechanism & Age

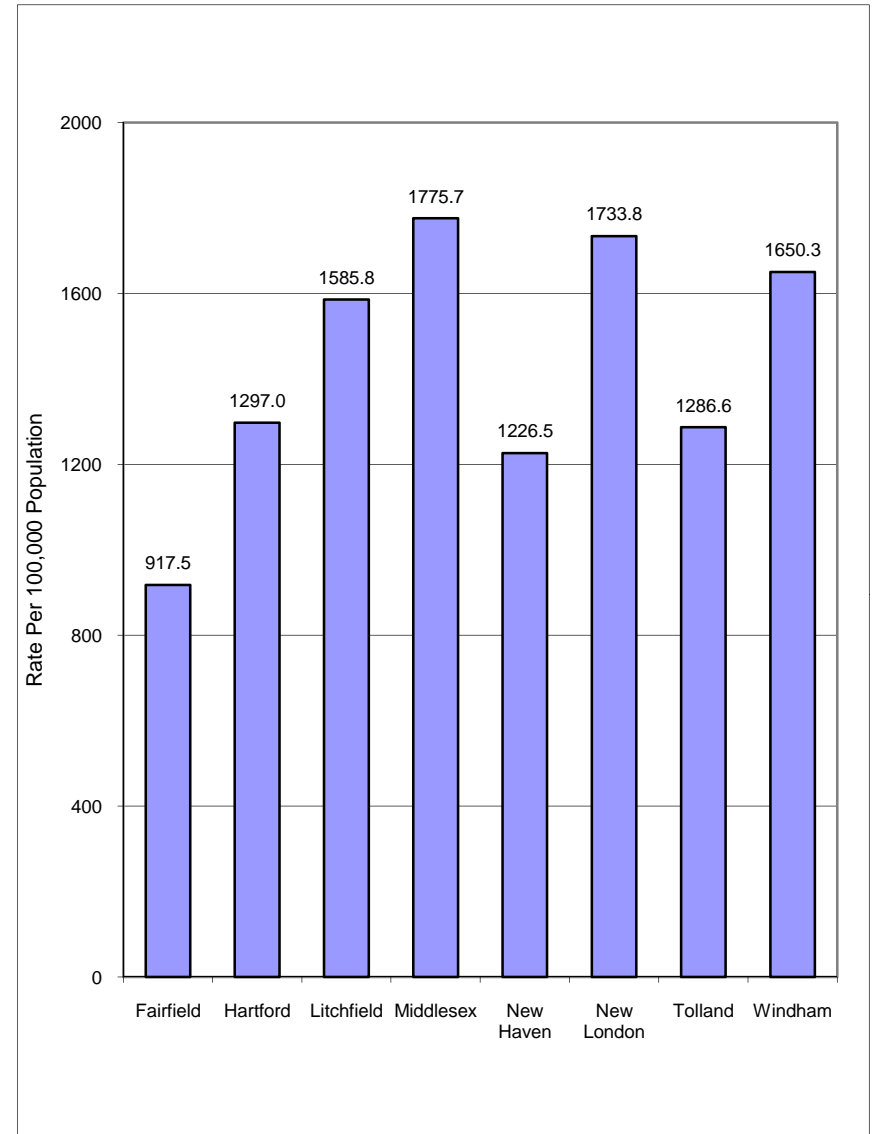
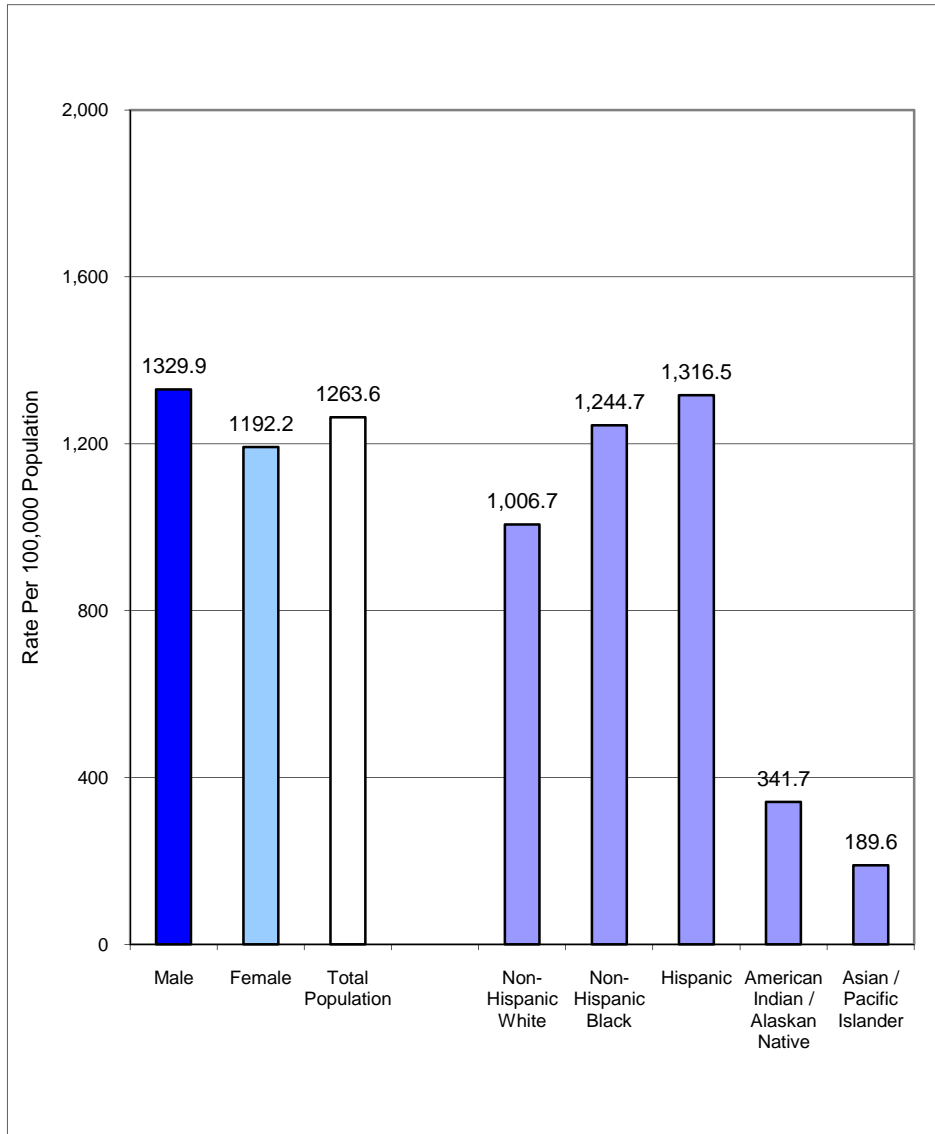

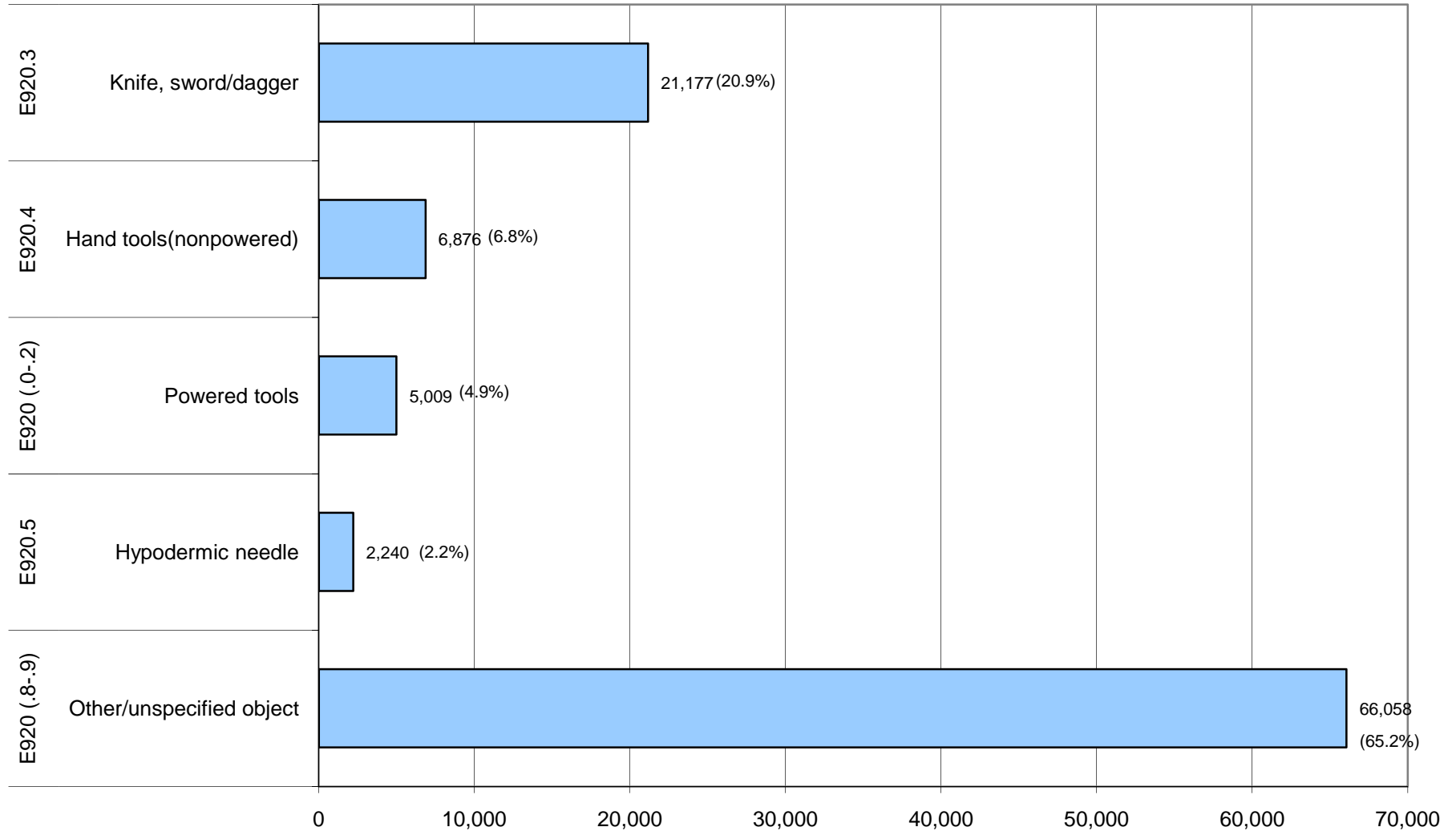
Overexertion ED Visit Rates by Age & Sex Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007



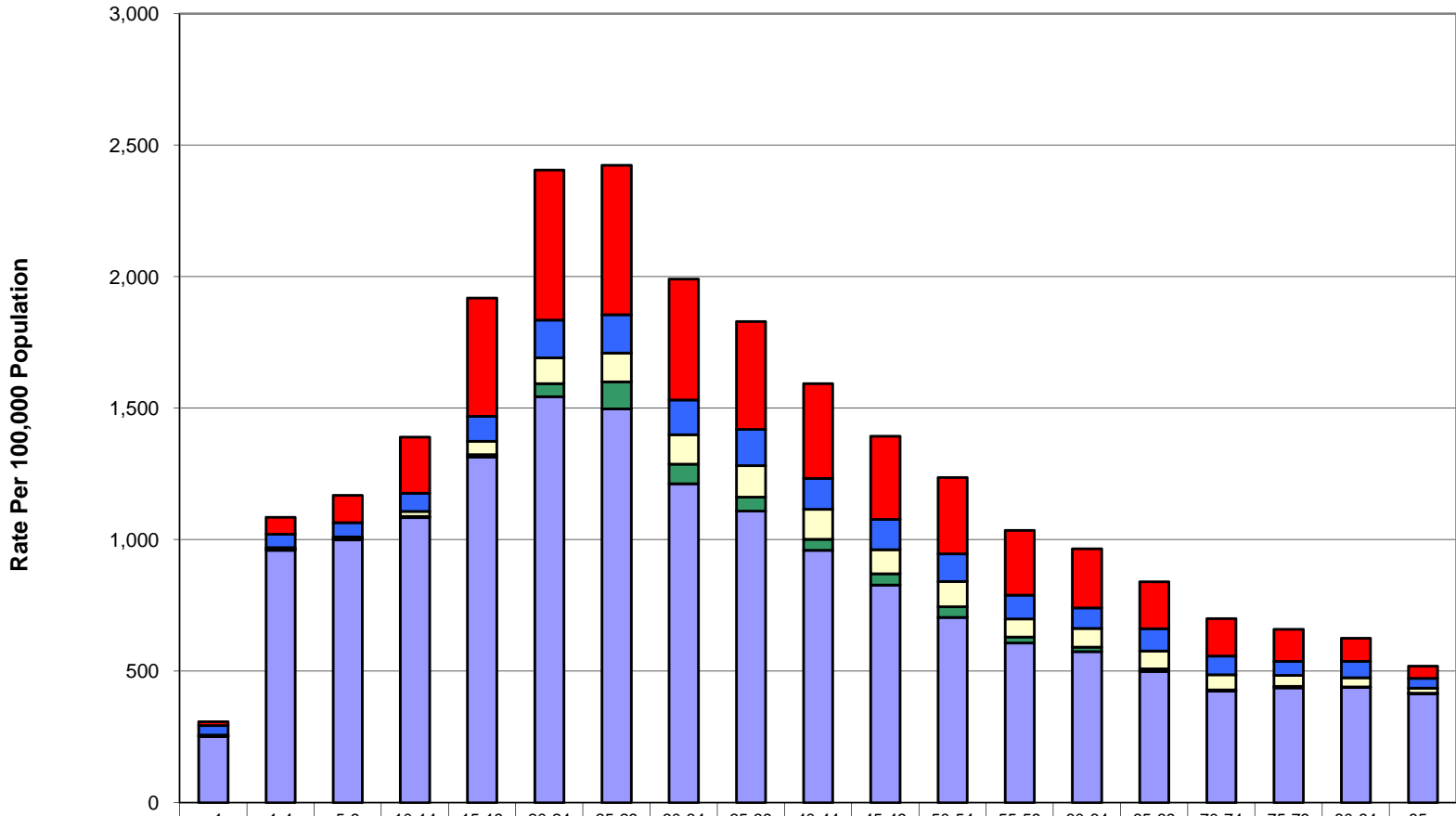
Age-Adjusted Overexertion ED Visit Rates by Sex, Race/Ethnicity & County of Residence Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007

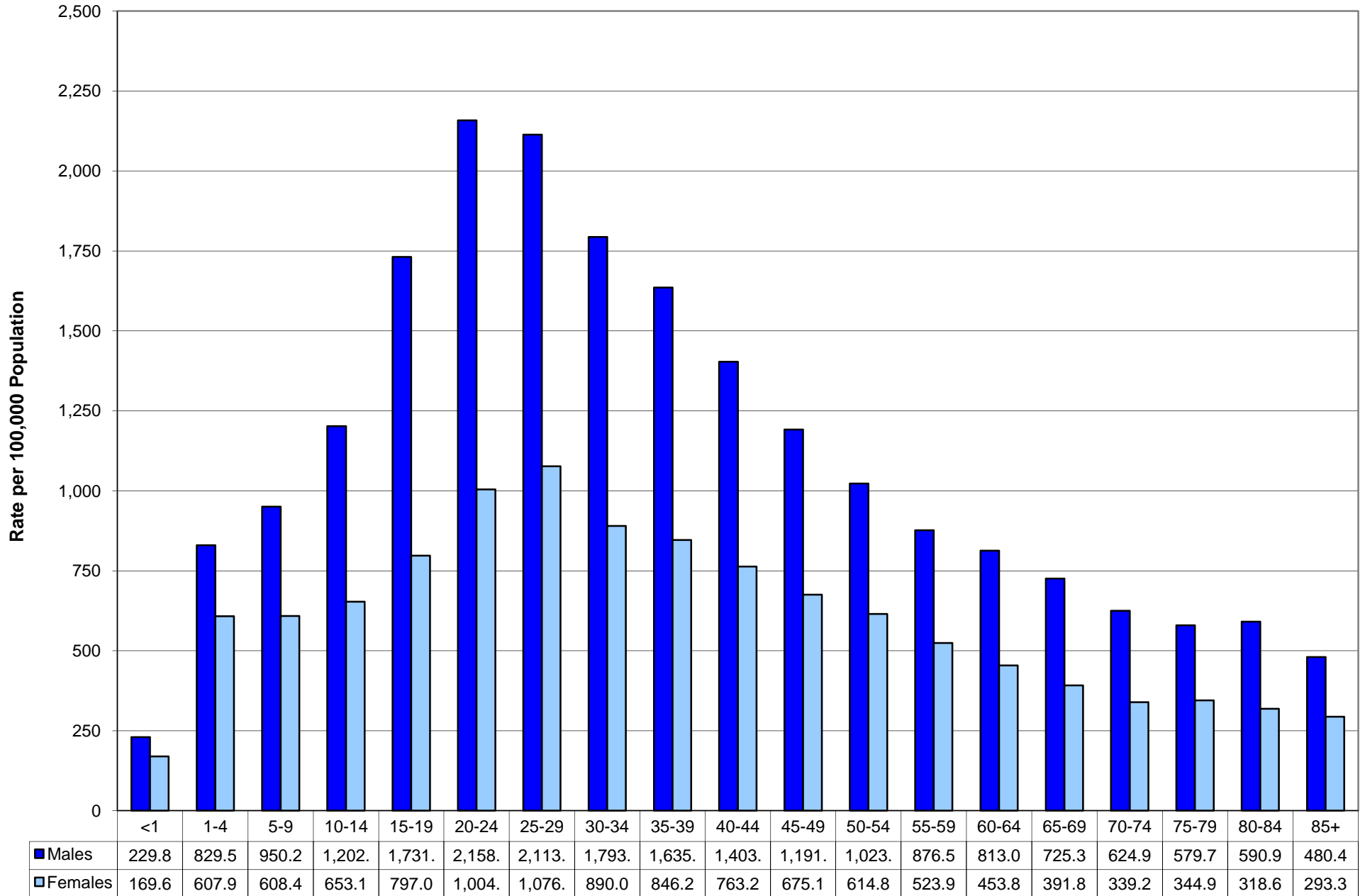


Cut/Pierce ED Visit Rates* by Mechanism & Age Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007

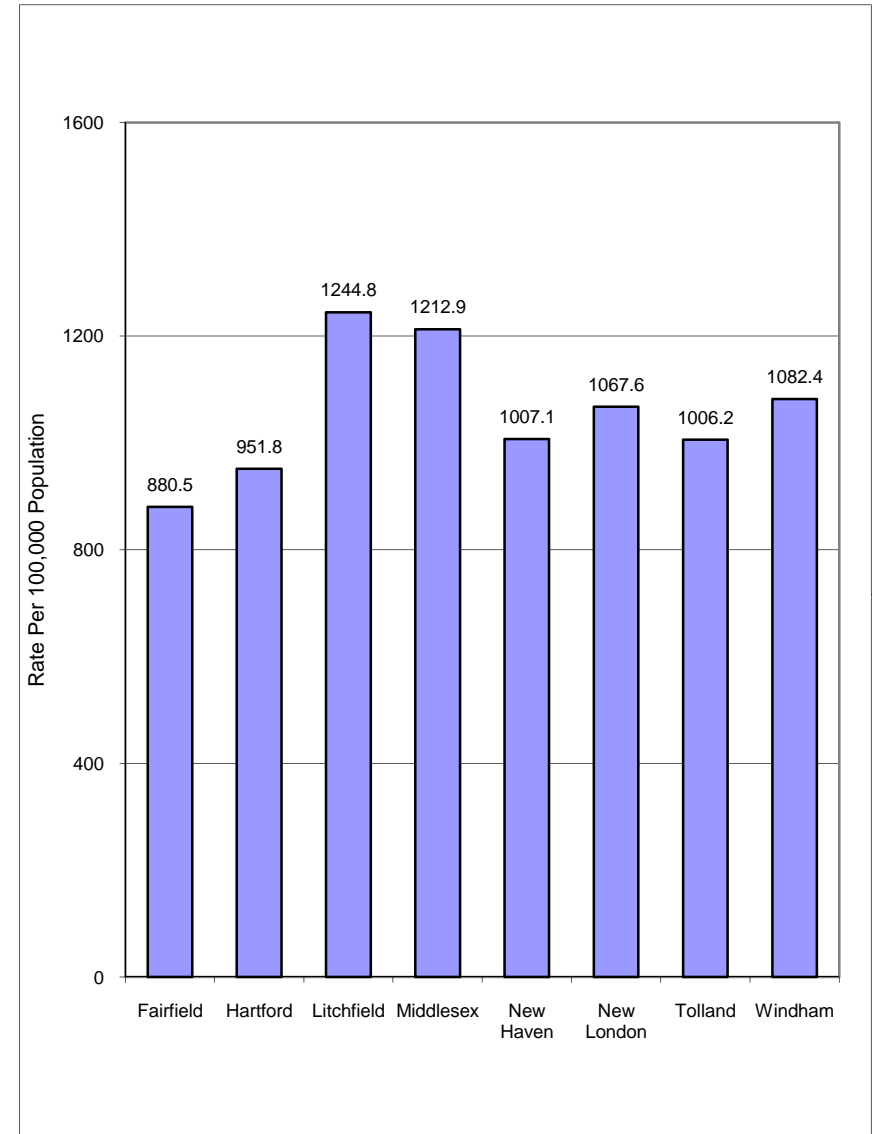
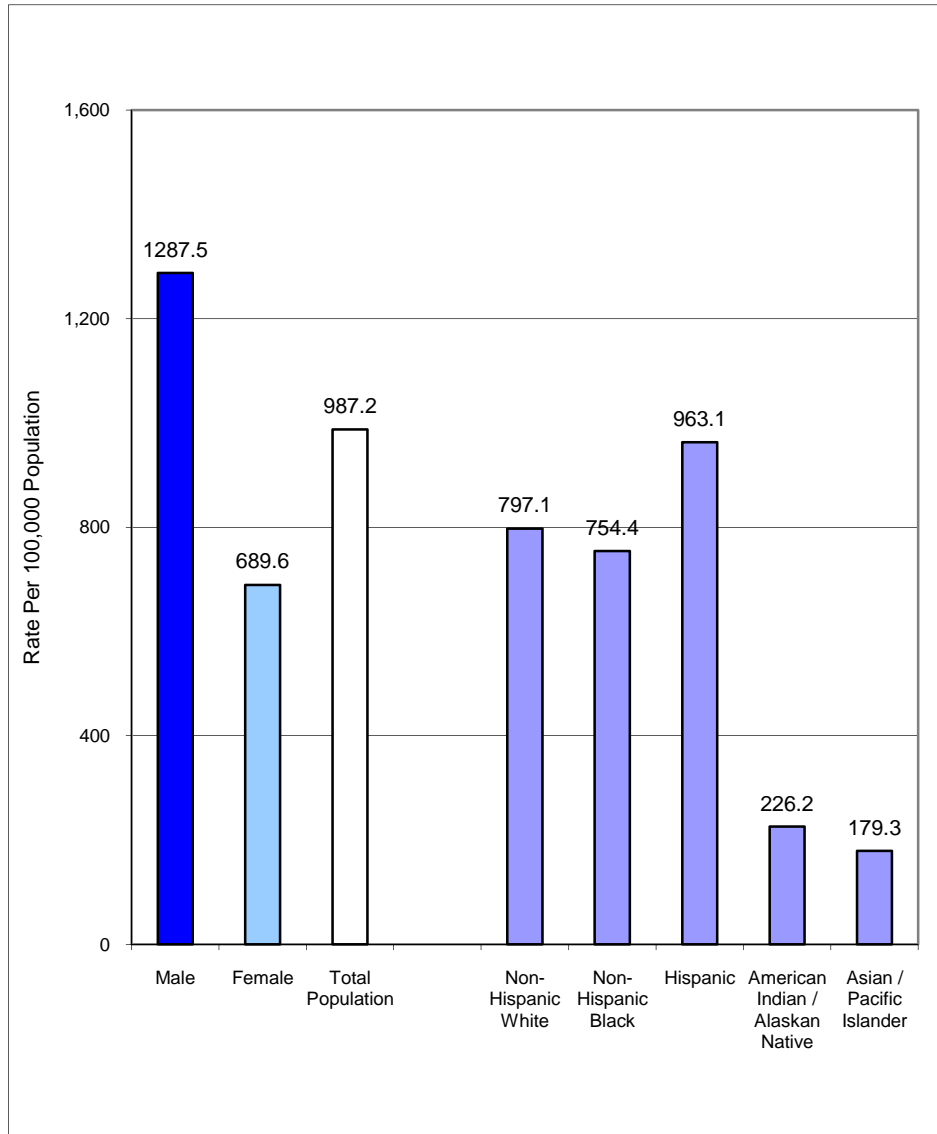

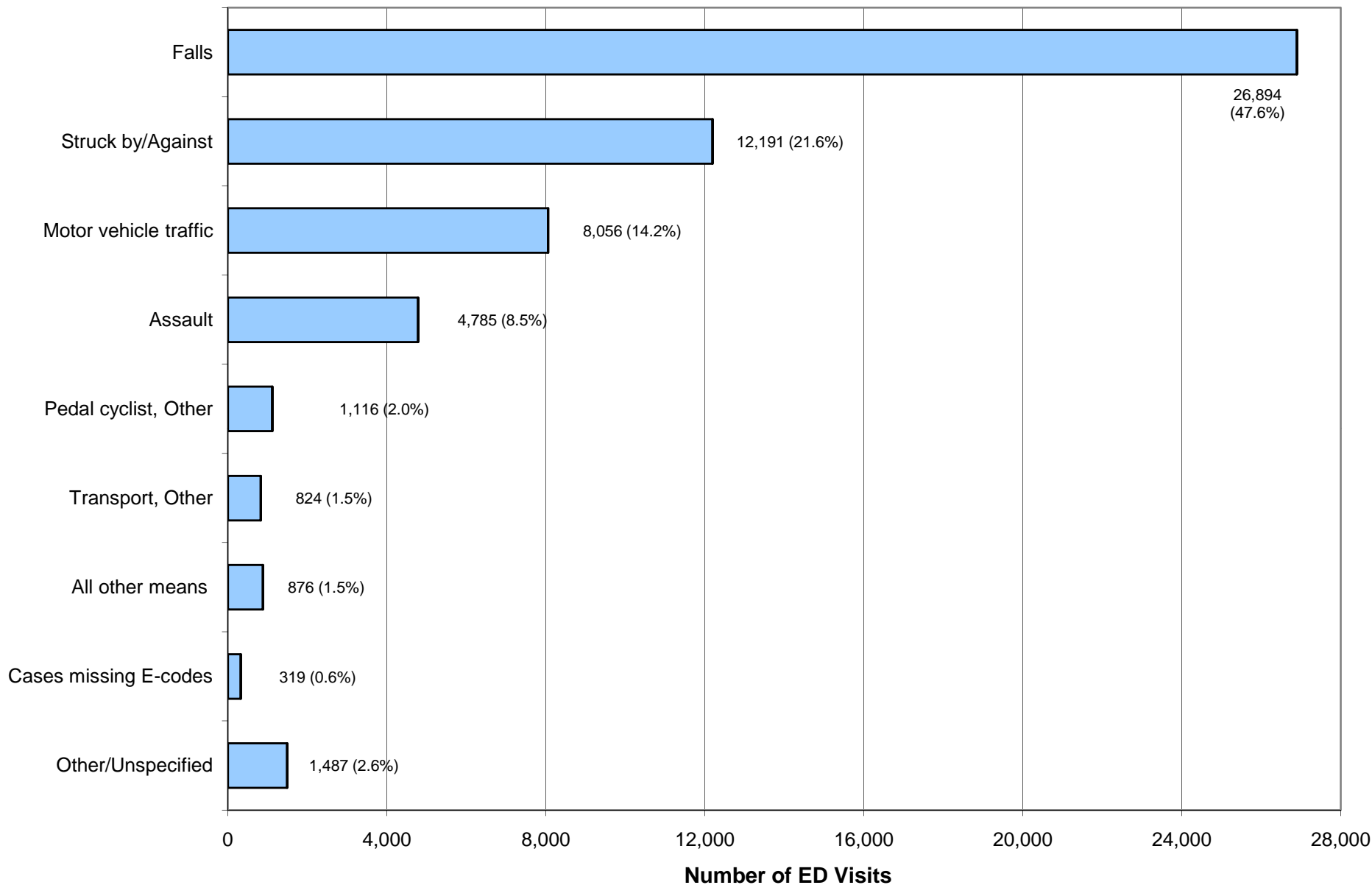
Cut/Pierce ED Visit Rates by Age & Sex Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007



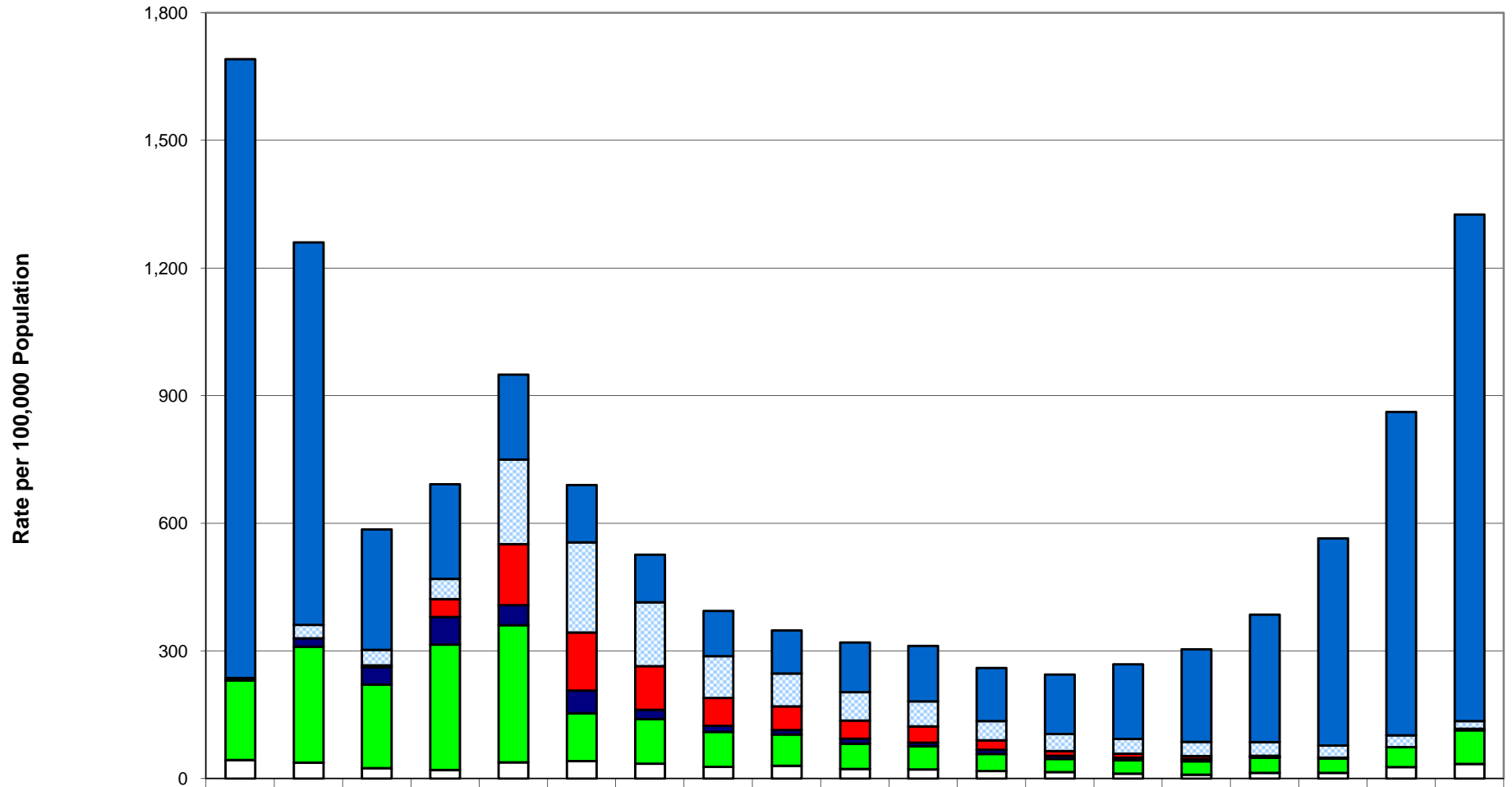

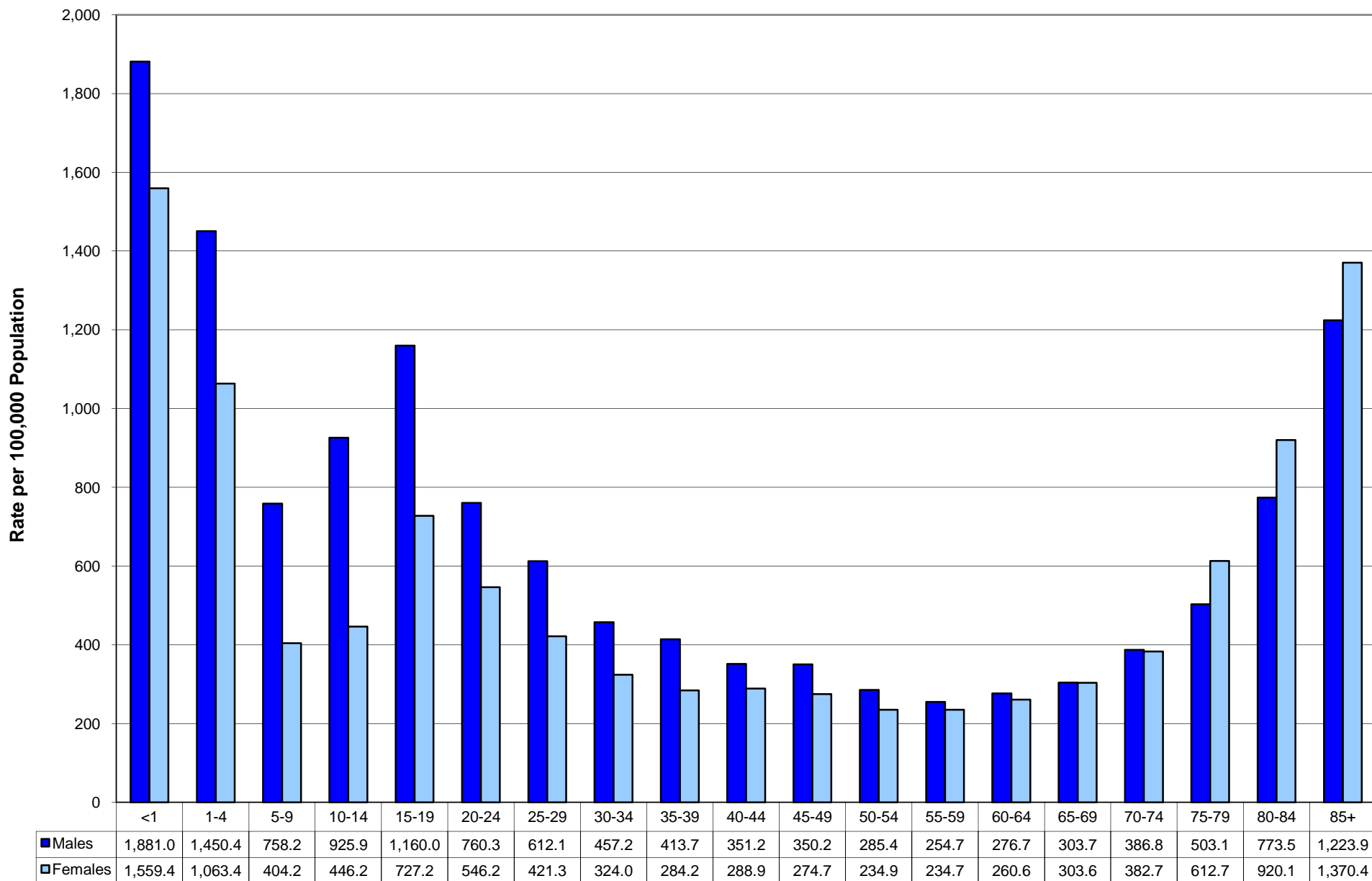

TBI ED Visit Rates by Age & Sex Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007

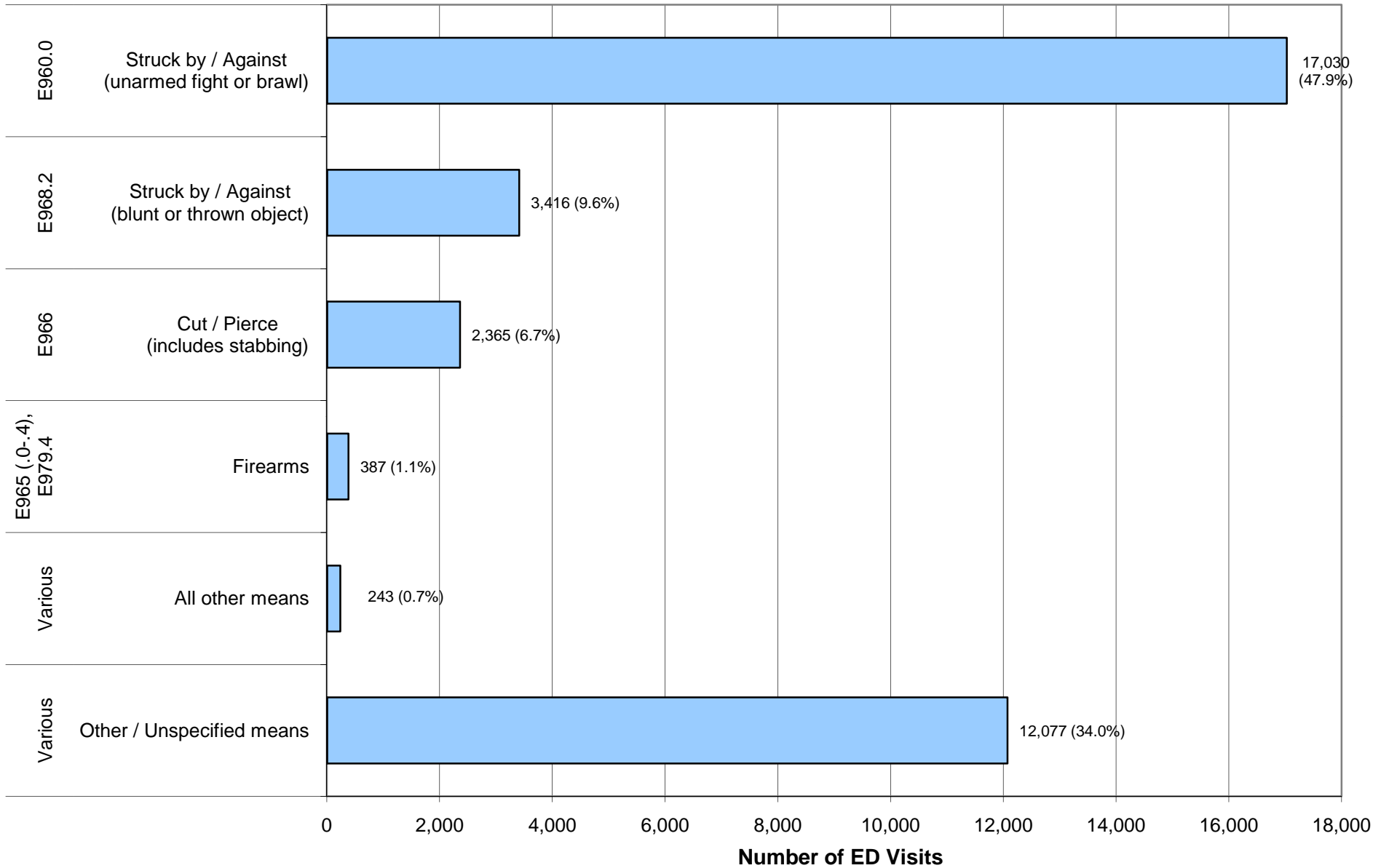


Age-Adjusted TBI ED Visit Rates by Sex, Race/Ethnicity & County of Residence

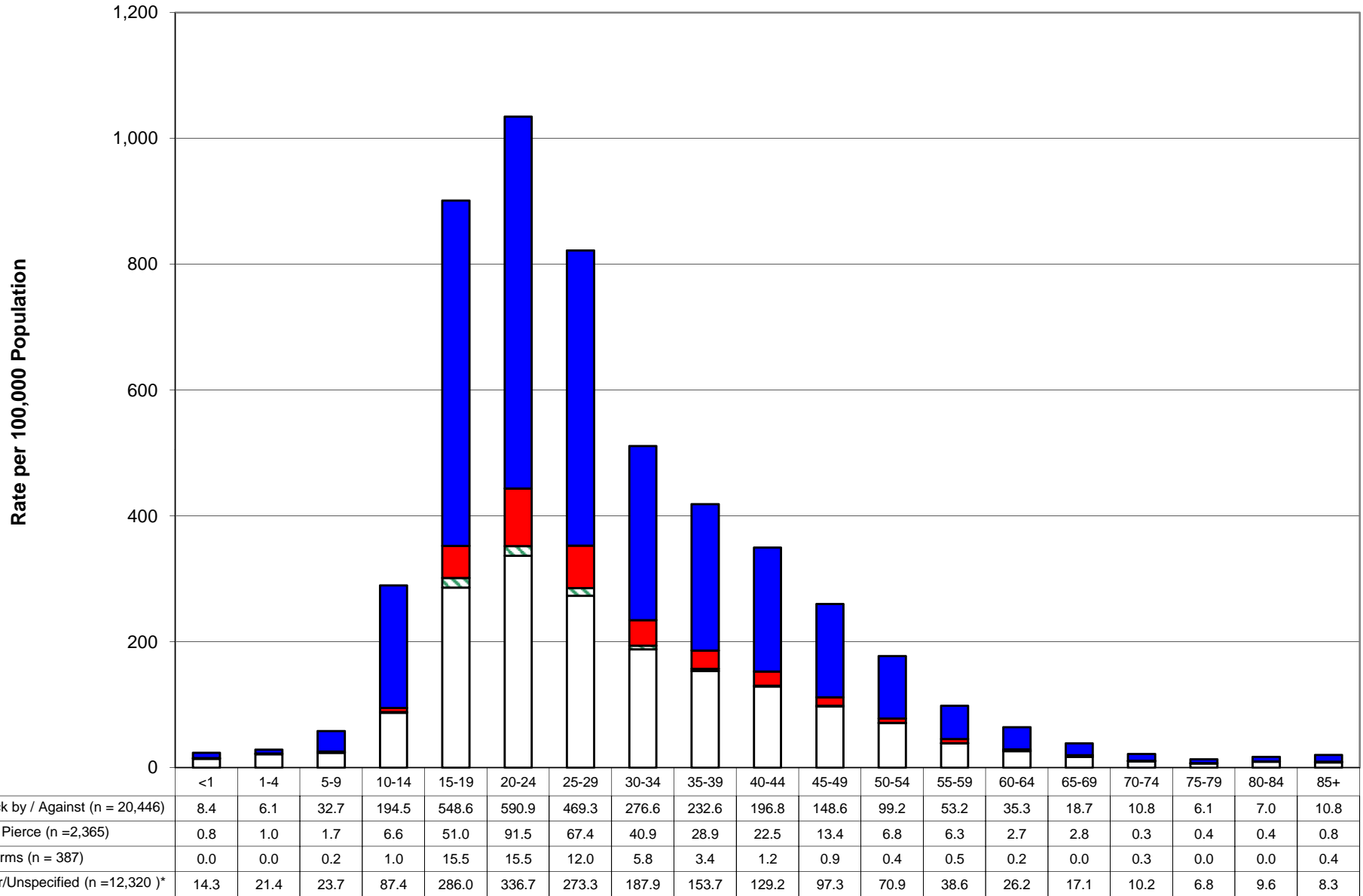

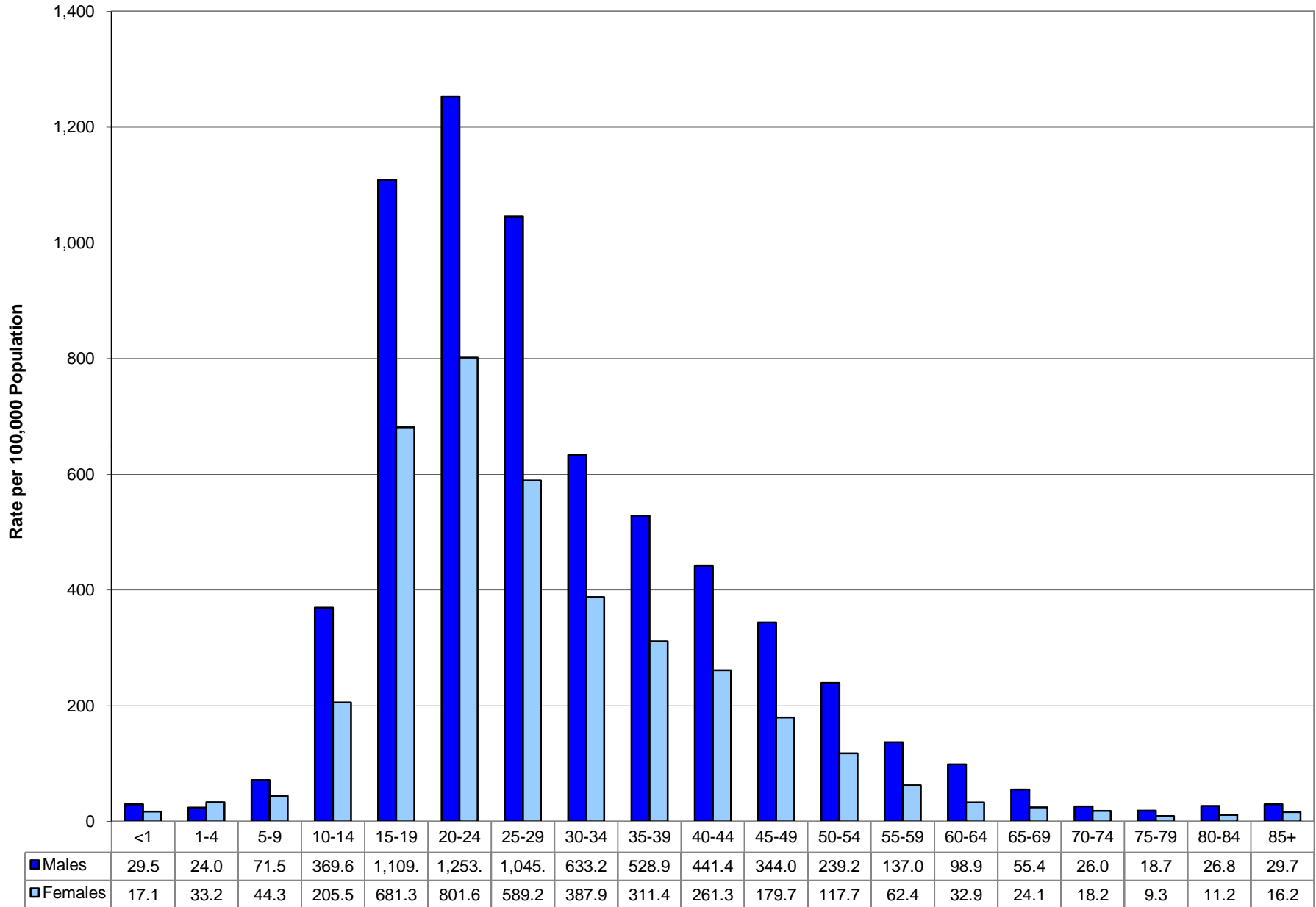


Assault ED Visit Rates by Mechanism & Age Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007

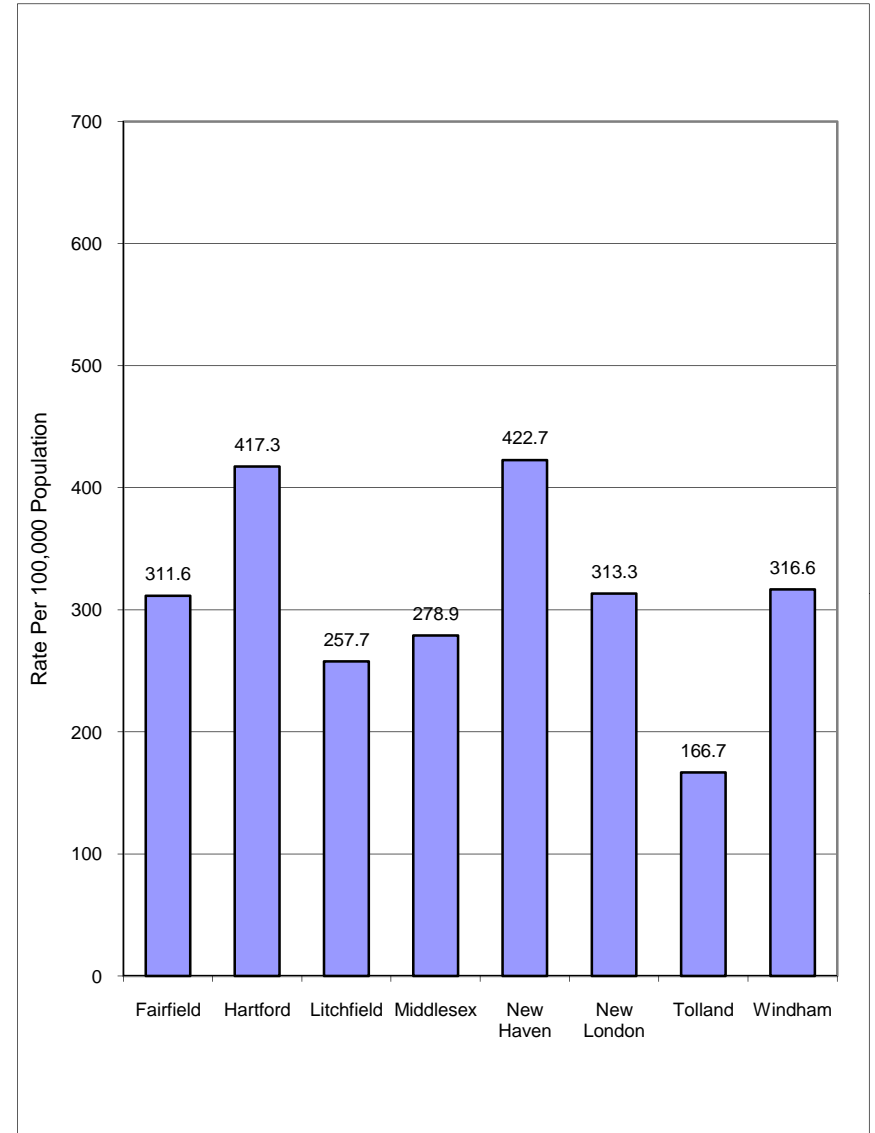
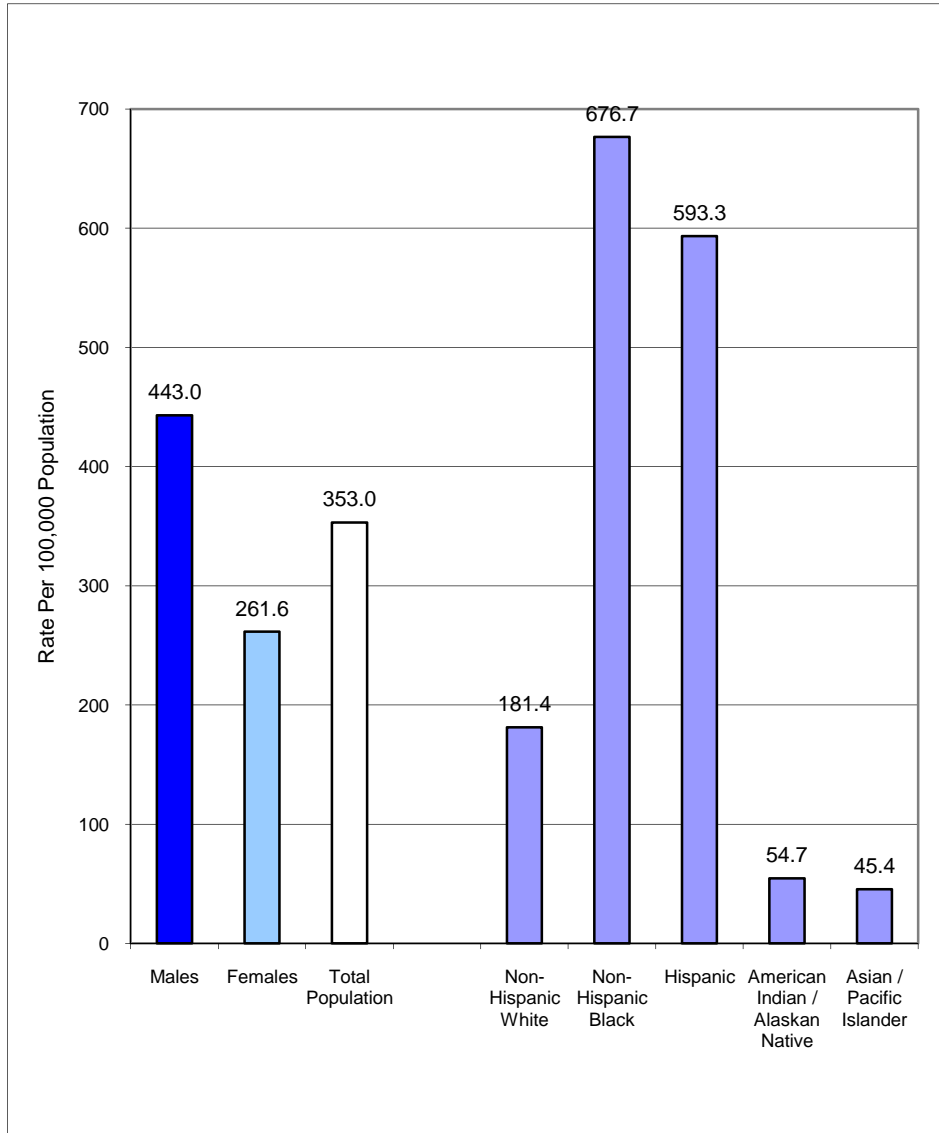

Assault ED Visit Rates by Age & Sex Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007



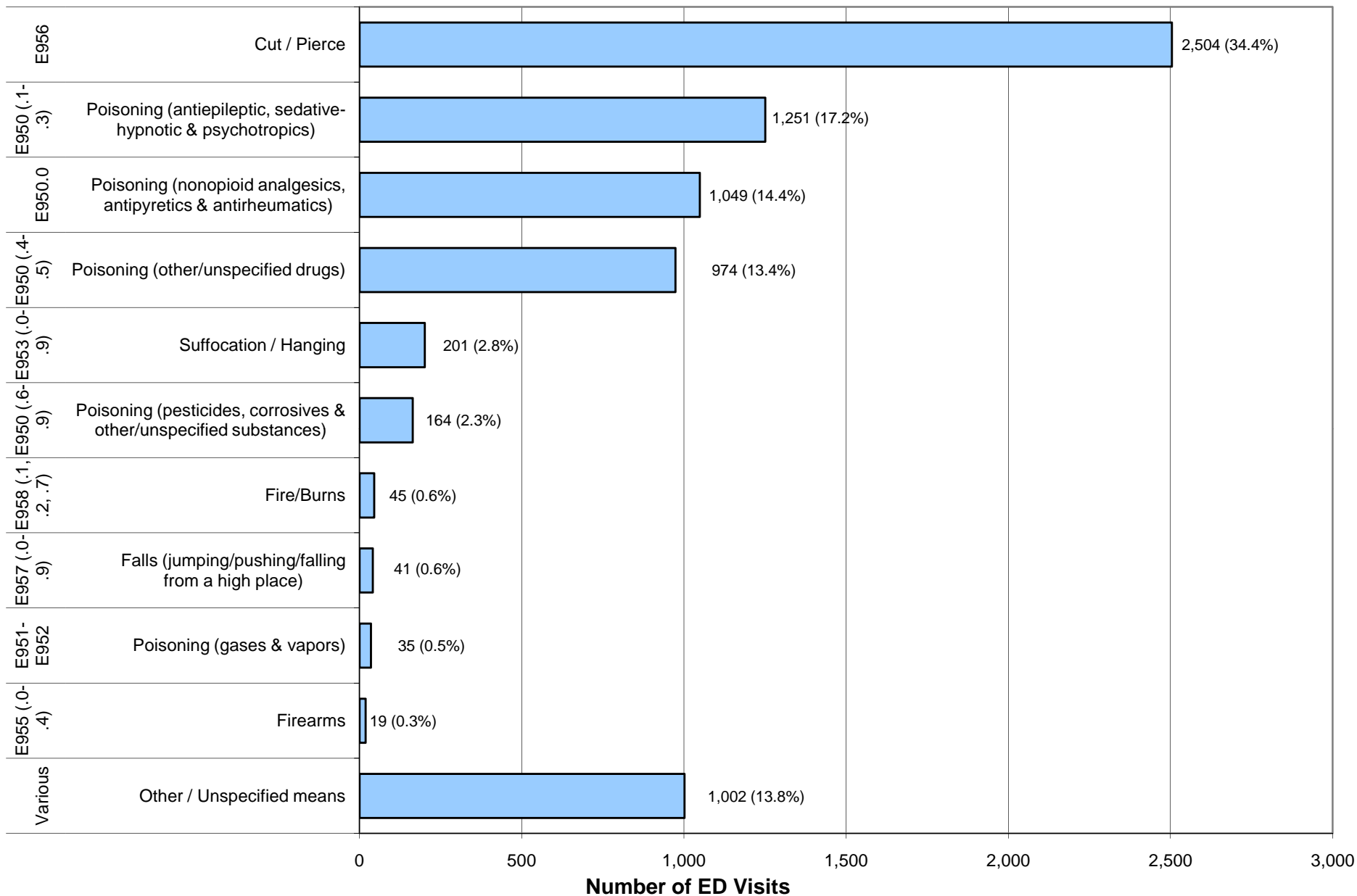
Age-Adjusted Assault ED Visit Rates by Sex, Race/Ethnicity & County of Residence Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007



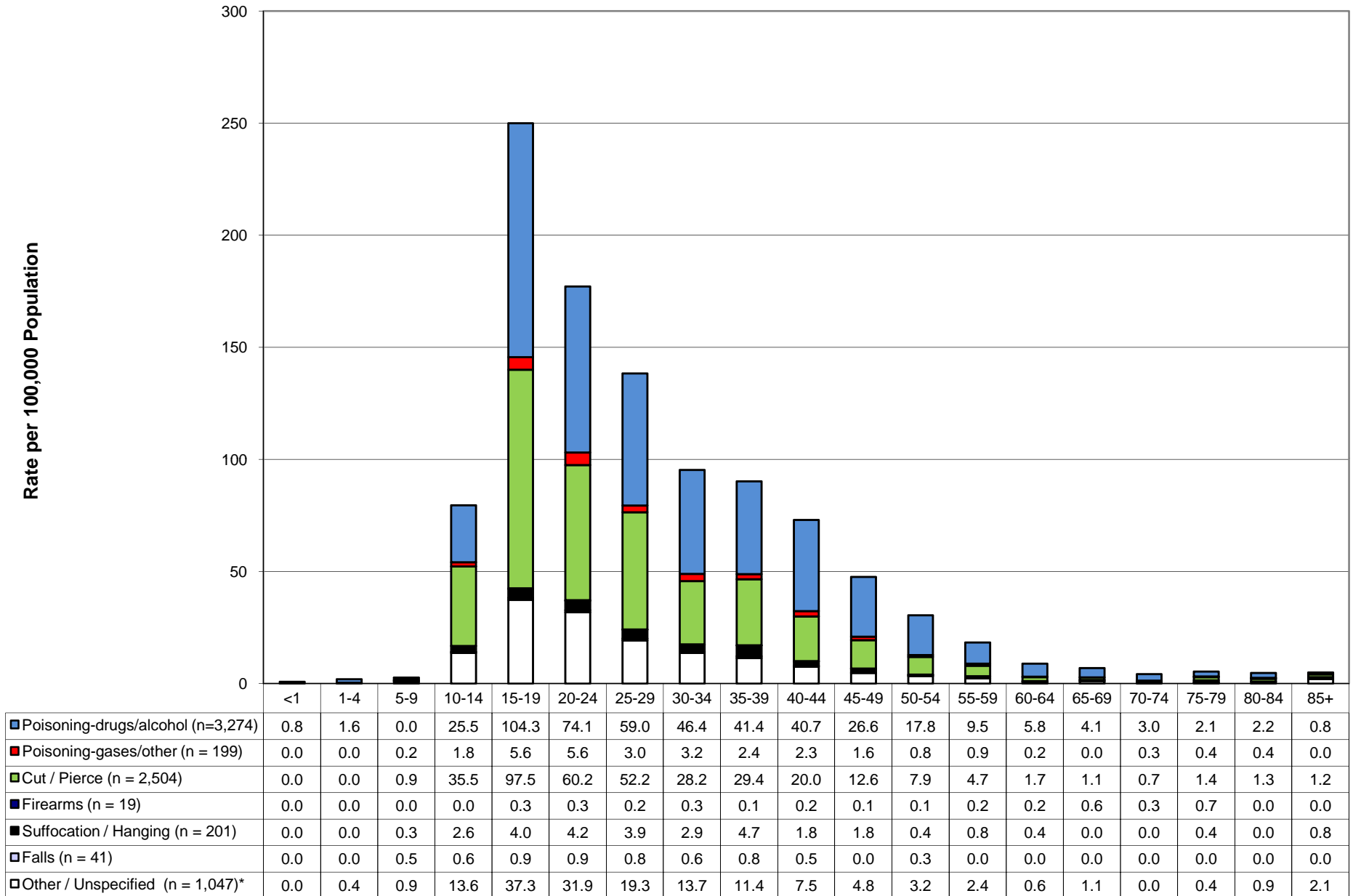
Self-Inflicted Injury* ED Visits by Mechanism

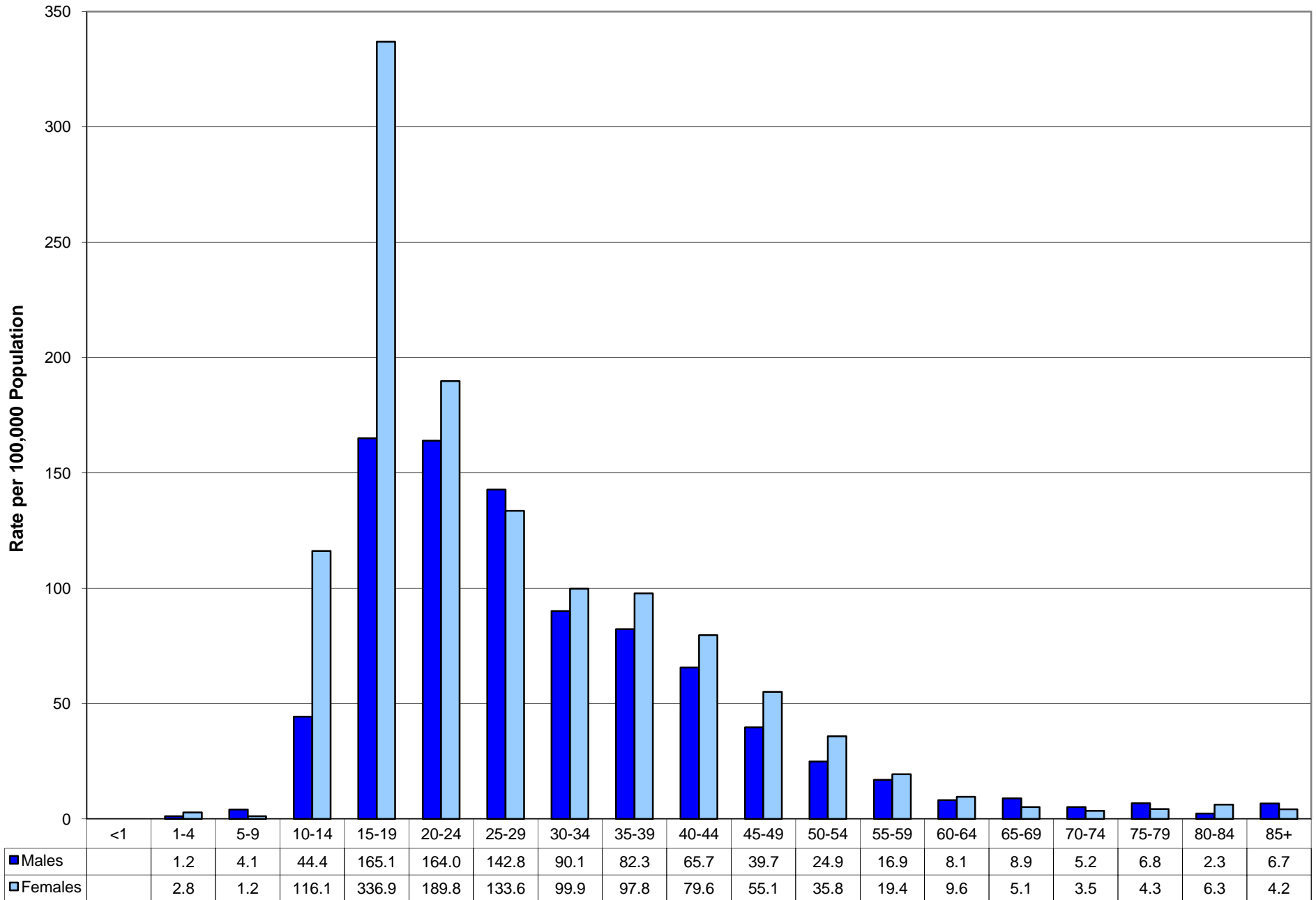
