DID YOU KNOW....

- Flu is a debilitating illness
- A person infected with influenza may be able to infect others before symptoms appear
- The flu virus is spread in respiratory droplets caused by coughing and sneezing
- The young, the elderly, and those with certain medical conditions such as asthma and diabetes are at high risk for complications of the flu
- \succ Every year 5% to 20% of the population gets the flu
- Flu vaccinations can reduce absenteeism from flu related illnesses by approximately 45%
- > Only 34% of 50 to 64 year olds get immunized
- More than 200,000 people are hospitalized every year from flu complications
- Annually about 36,000 people die from flu complications
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention states "the best way to prevent this illness is by getting a flu vaccination each fall".
