

Dental cleaning during the 12 months before pregnancy is based on Question 7: "At any time during the 12 months before you got pregnant with your new baby, did you do any of the following things?" Q7h:" I had my teeth cleaned by a dentist or dental hygienist."

Poverty Status: Federal Poverty Level was calculated using total household income in the previous year and the number of people in the household. Poverty status was grouped into the following categories: Poor ($\leq 100\%$ FPL), Near Poor (101-200\% FPL), and Not Poor (>200\% FPL).
