I. MINUTES

A. Federal Aviation Administration - BasicMed Comprehensive Medical Examination

The Board reviewed a letter from Ernest R. Marrone II, DC in which is requesting a declaratory ruling regarding the Federal Aviation Administration - BasicMed Comprehensive Medical Examination. Dr. Marrone also indicates that he waives the time requirement for the Board to issue a ruling.

Dr. Carucci made a motion, seconded by Dr Carroccia that the Board proceed with a declaratory ruling proceeding. The motion passed with Dr. Carroccia and Dr, Carucci voted in favor. Dr. Boghosian abstained.

The Board will hold a meeting on February 6, 2018 to review and vote on the Declaratory Ruling notice.

B. Annual Approval of Chiropractic Colleges/Universities

Dr. Carucci made a motion, seconded by Ms. Boghosian, that pursuant to § 20-27(d) of the Connecticut General Statutes, to approve only those colleges and universities that are accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education. The motion passed unanimously.

C. <u>Continuing Education Requirements</u>

Dr. Carucci made a motion, seconded by Dr. Boghosian, recommending that the mandatory continuing education topics include the following:

- 2 hours Mental health conditions common to veterans and their family members.
- 1 hour Manual therapies for chronic pain/management of patient's during the opioid crisis.
- 1 hour Lyme disease.
- 1 hour Medical marijuana eligibility and use.

The motion passed unanimously.
