II. MINUTES

The June 13, 2019 minutes were reviewed and approved on a motion by Mr. Carmon, seconded by Ms. Pier.

III. NEW BUSINESS

A. Reinstatement after practicing with a lapsed license

Stephen Carragher, Public Health Services Manager, DPH Practitioner Licensing Unit explained the current policy regarding practitioners who have continued to practice after their license has expired and are seeking reinstatement. The current policy requires a reinstatement consent order which imposes a reprimand and a civil penalty which is calculated based on the time period the practitioner has continued to practice.

Mr. Carmon made a Motion, seconded by Ms. Pier to endorser DPH's current policy/ The motion passed unanimously.

IV. BOARD MEMBER CONCERNS

Assistant Attorney General, Daniel Shapiro was present to discuss the process for issuing a potential declaratory rulings regarding a licensing question.

Questions pertaining the Department of Public Health investigations will be addresses at a future meeting.

V. OFFICE OF LEGAL COMPLIANCE

A. <u>Jennifer Tucci, Embalmer - Petition No. 2017-1234</u>

Diane Wilan, Staff Attorney, DPH presented a Consent Orders in this matter. Respondent was present but was not represented.

Mr. Bosak made a motion, seconded by Mr. Carmon, to approve the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Ms. Pier who was opposed.

Mr. McClam signed the order which imposes a reprimand.

B. Robert Bruzy, Embalmer - Petition No. 2018-969

Diane Wilan, Staff Attorney, DPH presented a Consent Orders in this matter. Respondent was present but was not represented.

Mr. Bosak made a motion, seconded by Ms. Pier, to reject the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Mr. Carmon who recused himself in this matter. The Board recommends a hearing in this matter.

C. Windsor Locks Funeral Home - Petition No. 2017-936

Diane Wilan, Staff Attorney, DPH presented a Consent Orders in this matter. Sean Stevens, owner of the Windsor Locks Funeral Home. was present but was not represented.

Mr. Bosak made a motion, seconded by Mr. McClam, to approve the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Ms. Pier who abstained and Mr. Carmon who recused himself in this matter.

Subsequent to discussion in which Mr. Stevens requested that he be able to obtain advice from his attorney, Ms. Pier made a motion, seconded by Mr. McClam to rescind the adoption of the Consent Order. The motion passed.
