B. Department of Public Health

Kathleen Boulware, Public Health Services Manager reported that the AMA guidelines concerning prescribing for family and friends as well as boundary issues have been added to the online license renewal web-site for review as part of the license renewal process.

IV. OFFICE OF LEGAL COMPLIANCE

A. Jonathan Parkhurst, MD - Petition No. 2015-1022

Staff Attorney David Tilles, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Richard Tynan was present on behalf of respondent.

Dr. Wolf made a motion, seconded by Dr. Green, to adopt the Consent Order. The motion passed with all in favor except Dr. Wolf, Ms. Jacklin and Ms. Rexford who were opposed.

Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand and license probation for 1 year.

B. Jennifer Matthesen, MD - Petition No. 2015-1096

Staff Attorney Diane Wilan, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Richard Brown was present on behalf of respondent.

Dr. Green made a motion, seconded by Dr. Hodgson, to adopt the Consent Order. The motion passed with all in favor except Ms. Jacklin who was opposed and Mr. McAnaney who abstained. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand and a \$1000.00 civil penalty.

C. David Burchenal, MD - Petition No. 2015-1094

Staff Attorney David Tilles, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Eugene Cooney was present on behalf of respondent.

Mr. McAnaney made a motion, seconded by Dr. Zeman, to adopt the Consent Order. The motion passed unanimously. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand, license probation for 3 years and an \$8000.00 civil penalty.

V. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

A. Oral Argument - Proposed Memoranda of Decision Josef Burton, MD - Petition No. 2014-739

Assistant Attorney General Kerry Colson was present to provide counsel to the Board. Respondent was present without representation. Staff Attorney Brittany Allen was present for the Department of Public Health.

The Board entertained comments regarding the proposed Memorandum of Decision from respondent and Attorney Allen.

Mr. McAnaney made a motion, seconded by Dr. Zeman, to adopt the decision as written. The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes license probation for 2 years, a \$2000.00 civil penalty and a restriction prohibiting the prescribing of schedule II – schedule V controlled substances.
