Prior to review of the Consent Order the Board heard argument from Attorney Moskowitz and Attorney Scoville regarding a Motion in Limine filed by respondent. Mr. Colangelo made a motion, seconded by Dr. Horn, to deny respondent's motion. The motion to deny was approved unanimously.

Mr. Colangelo made a motion, seconded by Dr. Campagna, to approve the Consent Order which imposes a one year period of probation. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Colangelo signed the Order.
