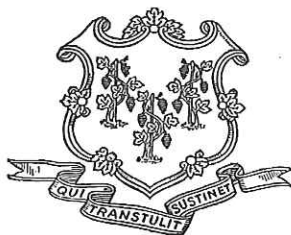

The contract between **Human Resources Agency of New Britain, Inc.** (the Contractor) and the Department of Social Services (the Department), which was last executed by the parties and approved the office of the Commissioner on 10/24/2013 is hereby further amended as follows:

1. The total maximum amount payable under this contract is increased by \$42,342 from \$1,606,299 to **\$1,648,641.00**. This increase is due to the federal increase to the annual allocation for each budget year.
2. The Agency address on Page 1 of the original contract shall be changed from 25 Sigourney Street, Hartford, CT 06106 to 55 Farmington Avenue, Hartford, CT 06105.
3. The budget on pages 27 and 28 of the original contract shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety by the budgets on pages 2 & 3 of this amendment.

All terms and conditions of the original contract, and any subsequent amendments thereto, which were not modified by this Amendment remain in full force and effect.


