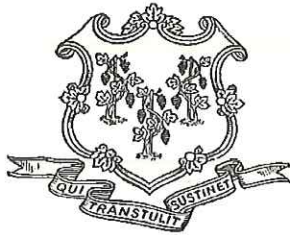

The contract between New Opportunities, Inc. (the Contractor) and the Department of Social Services (the Department), which was last executed by the parties and approved by the Office of the Commissioner on 09/30/14, is hereby further amended as follows:

1. Through this amendment the FFY2016 allocation of \$17,512,914 is hereby incorporated into the original contract. This funding will allow for the continuation of services during FFY2016, which is the second year of this three year contract. This funding will enable the Contractor to issue vendor payments on behalf of eligible households.
2. The respective Composite Administrative, Program Services and Assurance 16 budgets on pages 13 through 16 of the original contract are hereby deleted and replaced by the respective budgets on page 2 through 5 of this amendment. The budgets for Administrative and Assurance are subject to percentage limitations pursuant to the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Act, and as such may be adjusted during the program year should actual funding differ from the amount anticipated.

All terms and conditions of the original contract, and any subsequent amendments thereto, which were not modified by this Amendment remain in full force and effect.






