#### Call to Order

John Elsesser, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 1:02 p.m.

## **Approval of the minutes**

## **PSDN Technical Update**

Timothy Searles reported that since the last meeting staff members of the DAS/BEST team have:

- Provisioned Data-Center vrf L3VPN circuits for: York CI, DOC Wethersfield, Winsted DMV, Old Saybrook DMV, Norwich DMV, Waterbury DMV, Willimantic DMV, Norwalk DMV, Danbury DMV, New Britain DMV, Bridgeport DMV, and Hamden DMV
- Provisioned COLLECT vrf L3VPN circuits for: Foxwoods Tribal PD, Groton Long Point PD, Mohegan Tribal Public Safety, and Mohegan Sun Casino Substation.
- Provisioned CISS vrf L3VPN circuits for: Plymouth PD, Winsted PD
- Provisioned CEN internet transport for: Naugatuck PD, Haddam FD, Norfolk FD and Tolland County Mutual Aid
- Provisioned Trumbull PD L2VPN Network
- Completed PSDN DCN Management Network Repairs and Enhancements
- Re-provisioned 169 CCGW L2VPNs into CCGW routed network

## **Application Status Report**

John Masciadrelli reported that to date, 136 requests to access the Public Safety Data Network have been submitted to the PSDN Governance Board. 89 requests have been approved to operate on the PSDN. 70 requests are currently operating on the PSDN. There are an additional 17 requests awaiting an implementation date or are in the process of being implemented. The remaining requests are in various stages of the connection process. Two requests will be presented today.

## **Application Review and Approval**

Mr. Masciadrelli presented request NM16132, Orange Police Department is requesting access to the PSDN to transport Mobile Data Terminal (MDT) traffic between Orange PD and an AT&T Wireless point of presence (POP). The AT&Ts POP's equipment is collocated with PSDN equipment in the Hartford PD located at 253 High Street, Hartford, CT. Orange PD's MDT's will be used to access the following applications/services: Automatic vehicle location, ESET, Citrix Remote Desktop, Records Management System, COLLECT, and E-Citation. The MDT's will not have access to the internet. On October 16, 2017, Orange PD requested a location change and wireless provider change to request NM16132. Marc Montminy motioned to approve the request. Raffaella Coler seconded the motion. Request NM16132 was voted on and approved.

Mr. Masciadrelli presented request NM16253, Plainfield PD is applying to operate on the PSDN to provide connectivity between Plainfield PD and their remote radio base station repeater located at Ekonk Hill Road, Sterling. The Plainfield PD is currently communicating with the tower site over the air. A PSDN circuit will significantly improve efficiencies in service and reliability beyond what a radio frequency can provide. Raffaella Coler motioned to approve the request. Joanne Miles seconded the motion. Request NM16253 was voted on and approved.

Mr. Masciadrelli presented request NM16389, Vernon PD is requesting the use of the PSDN to transport P25 compliant radio traffic between a radio tower site located at 300 Box Mountain Road, Vernon and the Vernon PD. This is a Core request and no vote is necessary.

Mr. Masciadrelli presented request NM16301, Ledyard PD is requesting access to the PSDN for the purpose of transporting radio communications between Ledyard ECC, Montville ECC, Gales Ferry FD, Ledyard Fire Department and Connecticut State Police Tower site at Vinegar Hill Road. Joanne Miles motioned to approve the request. George Battle seconded the motion. Request NM16301 was voted on and approved.
