Reports which have been published by DMHAS for the period of October 6, 2011 through October 14, 2011 are listed below. A list of reports and descriptions of these reports may also be found in the **Reports Documentation** folders on the respective reports servers.

Enterprise Data Warehouse (EDW) Reports

- **URS Table 4 - Outcome Measures Folder** - This table provides a profile of adults who were active in community mental health programs by employment status.
- **URS Table 4A - Outcome Measures Folder** - Table 4A is similar to Table 4; however, it groups employment status by primary diagnosis. The primary diagnoses in this report are grouped into 5 diagnostic clusters and 6th grouping for No Diagnosis when the Axis I diagnosis is null.
- **URS Table 12 - Outcome Measures Folder** - Table 12, co-occurring clients, utilizes data from table 2, 14, and 16 to identify the percentage of total clients served by the state authority with substance abuse diagnoses and also identifies the percentage of clients with SMI who have a substance abuse diagnosis Table 12 also provides the percentage of state's clients with SMI.
- **URS Table 16 A B C 17B - Outcome Measures Folder** - Tables 16A, B, C, and 17B utilizes the clients who met criteria for SMI in Table 14a and 14b but provides a profile of clients receiving specific EBP services. Only use clients identified in Table 14a and 14b for this report.

AVATAR Reports

- **RVS Team Program Services - Census Folder** - This report is used to report a monthly list of clients assigned to each team, along with the clients assigned service provider and duration of service.

RMANS Reports

- **Unit MPI Lookup - RMANS Folder** - This report was mainly utilized for observation data entry. If a user did not have a Patient's MPI then they would look up the MPI by generating a census of Patients for one unit.
- **Restraint and Seclusion Detail - RMANS Folder** - Detail of restraint or seclusion (or both) events with breaking down each occurrence by patient, unit, & div. Each event is listed with the type of restraint or seclusion along with the duration of the event.
